FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for being part of this AutoSOLO, AutoTest & PCA 2023, co-promoted and organised by WSMC & MCAC with support from AMSC and from other clubs in the AMSC community.

Venue

The venue is Debden airfield near Saffron Walden. **OS Grid Ref**: TL 56678 34418 **Latitude**: 51° 59' 10" N **Longitude**: 0° 16' 48" E **Postcode** CB10 2YA What 3 Words: <u>https://what3words.com/climate.bland.sprouting</u>

The access and route instructions are in the Safety Manual which is also being published to Sportity. Please make yourself familiar with the contents of the manual for your safety and convenience and the safety of others.

Speed outside of the tests themselves should be kept very modest and there is an overall limit of 25 mph. Be aware that there may be people walking or cycling between tests.

Please do not drive on the grass unnecessarily and do not damage it please.

Security

As Debden is an active MOD base, please do not wander outside the area used for the tests and the paddock. Do not photograph or video any military equipment, buildings or personnel.

Timetable

On Sunday 23 July the timetable will be:

- 7.45am Access to the venue opens Please do not arrive earlier
- 8.00am Scrutineering opens
- 8:45am Access to the venue closes
- 9:00am Marshals Briefing
- 9.15am Drivers briefing
- 9:30am First test starts

We intend to hold at least two runs of each of four tests before a lunch break (we hope to run 3). We will then hold at least two runs at each of four tests that will have been reversed from the morning runs, all time permitting.

A lunch break is mandatory and engines must be switched off during this time. You will be informed when the lunch break begins and ends.

Entry to the venue

When you arrive at the entrance you will be checked in and directed to the paddock area, indicated in the diagram on the next page. Park to give at least 2 parking spaces between your area and your next-door area, you may use both sides of the runway.

The organiser's vehicle(s) will be in the Autosolo paddock close to the WSMC mobile van with an MCAC flag nearby. If you are a 'regular', note that the venue layout might be different to normal.

Processing and Sign-on

All competitors will need to go through a scrutineering and noise check within the paddock area so as soon as you are able to please queue up to complete this. When complete you will be given a test check sheet that you then take to the WSMC van to complete sign-on and receive your documentation. Please ensure that you have with you:

- A printed or electronic copy of your RS clubman licence or other Motorsport UK licence
- A printed or electronic copy of a valid club membership card


There is no need to bring details of your MOT or Tax as this has already been validated through the registration process.

In return for signing-on you will receive:

• Competitors door number – this should be fixed from the inside of the car to the rear window behind the driver's door (or as close as possible to this) so that the marshals can clearly identify you on the tests

In advance of the weekend

Test diagrams, timecards and start order for all classes are planned to be available from the Sportity site (info on how to access this is detailed further in this document) so please ensure you log into the site to print these off or save copies on your devices. We will have a very small number of spare copies but not enough for everyone!



How to monitor the results

The marshals use the timing app to record the times for each test and any penalties. These are compiled into an online results sheet that can be viewed whilst the competition is in progress.

You can install the app on your smart phone or tablet as follows:

- Android go to Google Play search for Autotest from Sapphire Solutions
- Apple go to App Store search for Production Car Autotest from Sapphire Solutions
- Alternatively open the website <u>https://autotest.sapphire-solutions.co.uk/eventlist.php?sitename=middxcc</u>
- Open the app and press Live
- Select the event WSMC/MCAC Summer AutoSOLO, AutoTest & PCA July 2023 and then click on Leaderboard

There are several different views – Minimum, Overall, Detailed and Sub-Totals – according to how much information you want.

Note that the rankings (e.g. 1st in class) will not necessarily be correct during the day as it will depend which scores have been received at the instant that you check the results.

Noise – This will be checked post scrutineering and then randomly tested throughout the day.

Appendix A - Paddock/Service Area Guidelines

Competitors should park in the paddock to leave at least 2 parking spaces between their area and the next-door area, you may use both sides of the runway.

It is not normally expected that vehicles will need servicing during an AutoSolo and no designated service area is provided.

However, it is acknowledged that some vehicles may need repair during the course of the event in which case the following Guidelines should be followed.

Competitors and any support crew should be aware of their own and other people's safety and well-being if working on their vehicle.

- No refuelling allowed due to the risk of spillage damaging the ground. An AutoSolo only requires a small quantity of fuel to complete the event so refuelling should not be required. The nearest roadside fuel stations are Pace Thaxted Road, Tesco Saffron Walden and Gulf in Newport. Please ensure you have sufficient fuel to last through the day.
- 2. If a vehicle has to be jacked up take special care.
- 3. No working under a vehicle unless properly supported on axle stands, ramps or a car trailer.
- 4. If a spillage of oil or other fluid occurs a spill kit (either the competitors own or the organisers available at Signing On) must be used to clear up the spill. The CofC must also be informed of the nature and location of the spill. The liability for any spill and remediation is the responsibility of the competitor
- 5. Fire extinguishers are available at the event office.
- 6. First Aid kit is available at the event office.
- 7. Tyres should only be inflated with portable 12 volt compressors or foot pumps.
