Final Instructions To Marshals

Thank you for being part of this event organised by SCCON & AMSC with support from organisers and marshals from other clubs within the AMSC. Your help is greatly appreciated!

Venue

The venue is Snetterton Circuit, NR162JU, off the A11, 10 miles northeast of Thetford. Access to the venue is via the main entrance. (Map ref: 144 / 007½ 896)

The access and route instructions are in the Safety Manual which is also being published to Sportity. Please make yourself familiar with the contents of the manual for your safety and the safety of others.

Please park in the green Marshals and trailers parking area (top right of map).

Space will be limited in the main paddock area.

8.00am Scrutineering opens – noise test at Test 1 before 1st run

8.05am Signing on opens

9.00am First test starts

10mph MAX speed limit on site. Be aware of pedestrians when manoeuvring around the paddock and driving to tests. The venue is open to the public on the day so there will be pedestrians.

We intend to hold three (3) runs of each of four (4) tests before lunch break.

Lunch - Tyrells open serving hot food! - Duration ~1 hr.


Help will be available for those who don't have access to a smart phone.

"Paper-less" Autosolo

Following other AMSC rounds, we are minimising paperwork with the exception of:

Check Sheets & Test Diagrams - These will be provided to Marshals via a Marshals pack for each of the test locations, along with information on the TimingAppLive password.

These will also be available on the Sportity app prior to the event if marshals which to review or print their own.

New to marshalling?

What to bring (in order of importance): Warm waterproof clothing. A high-vis vest, a pen/pencil and a clipboard, snacks and drinks, a whistle and a phone charging battery if you have one. Ask lots of questions to the other marshals on your test. You will be with experienced people.

Timing

Timing will be via the mobile app: "TimingAppLive". You can install this app on your smart phone or tablet. Search the Android or Apple app stores for "timingapplive" from Sapphire Solutions .Ltd



If you are a start and/or finish marshal, you will need to operate the following: Open the app, press Login and enter the code that will be supplied on the day. Select "app timing" then the event: "29 Oct 2023 Snetterton Autosolo" Then "Start and Finish". You will now be in the tests screen.



If you are able to, please bring along additional battery charging facilities to avoid your mobile running out. Come to the SCCON trailer at lunch if you need your phone charging.

We hope to be able to allocate at least 2 timing marshals to each test, one using the app timing the competitor, complete the timing by calling them away from the stop line, adding any penalties to the app, then calling the time out loud to the second marshal who is manually recording the time as a backup.

Noise – this will be randomly tested throughout the day.

Radios

There will be PMR radio handhelds operating on Channel 9 for event management. Channels 5 (test1), 6 (test2), 7(test3), 8 (test4) for each test.

There will be two handheld radios per test.

Use the person's name for all formal communication. Precede calls with safety or urgent as appropriate if dealing with event management or an incident. Wait out if an urgent call is in progress.
