Catering

Tyrells Café will be open! Please patronise the canteen for lovely hot meals! Allow marshals to queue jump so afternoon tests can be opened sooner.

Timetable

CLOCKS GO BACK 1hr ON SUNDAY 29th OCTOBER!!!

7:30am Gates open

8.00am Scrutineering opens – noise test at Test 1 before 1st run
8.05am Signing on opens (You need a scrutineering pass ticket first!)

Tests open to walk

8.45am Drivers' briefing 9.00am First test starts

10mph MAX speed limit on site. Be aware of pedestrians when manoeuvring around the paddock and driving to tests. The venue is open to the public on the day so there will be pedestrians.

We intend to hold three (3) runs of each of four (4) tests before lunch break.

Lunch - Tyrells open serving hot food!

Duration ~1 hr. Listen out to a marshal/organiser shouting out restart time and that afternoon tests are open to walk.

AMSC Challenge 2023 Group Photo!

10 minutes before afternoon tests start – all competitors and marshals to gather on test 2 with their cars. Please squeeze the cars together pointing toward the staircase with the photographer waving their arms!

We intend to hold two (2) runs of each of four (4) tests in the afternoon. Runs in the morning or afternoon may be shortened if the event is running behind schedule.

End Of Day Clear Up And Awards

PLEASE help pile up cones in stacks of 5. A pair of pliers/scissors to remove cable ties. Carry singular cones only, do not attempt to pick up piles of cones.

Awards of the day presentation at SCCON trailer (or Tyrells if inclement weather) after tests cleared.

Scrutineering

All competitors need to go through scrutineering first, collect a "pass ticket".

The scrutineers will find you in the paddock and check the following:Tyres - Minimum Depth 1.6 mm No obvious bulges or damage
Wheel Nuts/Studs are present and tightened
Seat Mountings secure - including passengers in the PCA class
Steering wheel secure
Brake Pedal has a solid feel
No loose items in car or boot (e.g tools/jacks)
Under Bonnet - no loose cables /pipes.
Yellow tape on Battery Earth Terminal . We have some available
No leaks.
Spill Kit in car – optional

MOT and tax status of vehicles for classes A1, A2, B and C will be checked electronically by organisers. Vehicles in these Autosolo classes must be driven to the event.

Noise

Cars will be asked to start up to ensure the exhaust system is working. The scrutineer does have a noise meter and some cars will be checked in accordance with J 5.17 & 18 in the Motor Sport Regulations. Noise levels may be checked at scrutineering or during the day in the queue to a test.

Processing and Sign-on

With your pass ticket from scrutineering in hand, go to the black SCCON club trailer to sign-on presenting your club card & MSUK RS Clubman's licence (printed or electronic copy on your phone).

You will receive car numbers to display on the inside of your rear side windows (or side of car for soft-tops).

There will be no other paperwork provided.

All other paperwork will be available electronically on the Sportity mobile app. Help will be available for those who don't have access to a smart phone.




How To Monitor Results
