Subject: Bonus Starting Point Events for EHRC Pre-92/Pre-2000.

In line with the 2026 FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations (available at www.fia.com), the FIA confirms the following events have been selected to offer additional starting bonus points in the 2026 season. The events selected are shown below:

<i>FIA EHRC Pre-92 Championship</i>	<i>FIA EHRC Pre-2000 Championship</i>
<i>Rally Storico Costa Smeralda (ITA)</i>	<i>Historic Rallye Weiz (AUT)</i>
<i>Rali Ceredigion (GBR)</i>	<i>Ulster Historic Rally (GBR)</i>

For the avoidance of doubt: 2026 FIA EHRC fully registered competitor(s) entering one (or both) of the rallies in the Pre-92 or the Pre-2000 championship will score 10 starting points at each event providing both crew members start the qualifying event from TCO onwards.

Bonus starting points will be awarded to both driver *and* co-driver. Bonus Points will be automatically awarded by the FIA EHRC Championship Administrator. Competitors do not have to enter *both* rallies in their championship to qualify for the starting points bonus.

In the event that one or both of the rallies are cancelled in their respective championships, the FIA reserves the right to cancel the implementation of these additional bonus starting points. All other qualifying rounds of FIA EHRC Pre-92/Pre-2000 in 2026 will offer normal bonus starting points, as described in the 2026 FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations.

Note: This communication does not apply to the FIA EHRC Gravel Championship. No events in the Gravel Championship offer extra starting bonus points other than the standard bonus starting points stated in the Sporting Regulations.
