## **Subject: FIA Wildcard Entrants | Seeding/Start Order Clarification.**

The FIA wishes to clarify the subject of *FIA Wildcard Entries* and running order in the 2025 FIA European Historic Rally Championship, **effective immediately** and ahead of Round 2, Historic Vltava Rallye. FIA Wildcard entrants are not eligible to score points within FIA EHRC.

Article 4.1.6 of the 2025 FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations states:

**Art 4.1.6**: Wildcard registrations will provide Competitors with the following benefits:

- Seeded <u>within</u> the main FIA EHRC field, on expected performance order <u>on all days</u> of the competition
- Service area allocation within the main FIA EHRC service area.
- Support from the FIA on-event team.

The FIA acknowledges that the event Supplementary Regulations for the opening rounds of the championship have stated a difference to this regulation, *indicating that FIA Wildcard entrants will 'follow'* the main EHRC registered competitors on Leg 1 and in the Starting Order.

Event bulletins will be published from <u>both</u> *Historic Vltava Rallye* and *Rallye Antibes VHC* to correct their Supplementary Regulations on start order in accordance with Art, 4.1.6.

Article 4.1.6 of the FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations 2025 is the <u>correct definition</u> of where an FIA Wildcard entry will be seeded in an event based on their entry under Wildcard status.

For clarity, FIA Wildcard entries (in Categories 1-4) are to be seeded <u>within</u> the EHRC registered crews on performance grounds, as the above regulation states on all remaining rounds of FIA EHRC 2025.

This is a *clarification only* and the Supplementary Regulations for events listed above will be updated by official bulletin through their own official noticeboard (ONB).
