

FIA EHRC 2024: Statement on Rallye Elba Storico.

Thursday 3rd October 2024.

Dear friends of the FIA European Historic Rally Championship,

The FIA is aware of an incident on Rallye Elba Storico, a round of the 2024 FIA European Historic Rally Championship, where a national championship competitor cited an act of sabotage to their car during parc fermé as the reason for their retirement.

Although the competitor was not registered for the FIA EHRC, the FIA takes such matters very seriously and condemns any act of sabotage which has no place in our sport at any level.

We have proactively contacted the event organiser to request an investigation into the incident and provide their findings.

Furthermore, the FIA has requested that the organisers of upcoming FIA EHRC events re-check their overnight parc fermé security procedures.

Our FIA Sporting Delegate will carry out an assessment onsite at each event to ensure the appropriate security measures are in place.
