

FIA European Historic Rally Championship 2025.

Official Championship Communication / Bulletin 5:

Subject: Gravel Tyre Quantity Limit 2025.

The FIA issues this official championship bulletin to update competitors in regard to *Article 15* of the FIA EHRC Sporting Regulations 2025 – "*Tyre Quantities*".

Within this article, it states that the tyre quantity limit for **gravel events** is set at <u>12</u> tyres in total.

As the **Historic Acropolis Rally** will run earlier in the calendar year in 2025, the FIA Historic Department recognises that for some teams this may cause some genuine challenges, especially in hot weather and on abrasive surfaces where tyre wear can be excessive.

This bulletin is to confirm that following internal review and some competitor feedback, the FIA Historic Department authorises a change to this stated limit by way of this official bulletin:

For the gravel only events in 2025 FIA EHRC, the limit for gravel tyres is now changed to <u>20</u> <u>tyres maximum</u> for all competitors who enter through the FIA registration system.

All tyres used must be self-registered during the event.

An updated version of the FIA Tyre Registration form will be provided to competitors for <u>both</u> gravel events in 2025 at scrutineering for those rallies.

For clarity, the events affected by this bulletin are the **Lahti Historic Rally (FIN)** and **Historic Acropolis Rally (GRC).** This bulletin does <u>*not*</u> apply to tarmac rallies in FIA EHRC where the limit will remain at 16 tyres maximum for the remainder of the 2025 season.
