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Remainder:

1. The entry and entry fee payment closing date for Round 5 was **27 June 2025 (midnight)**, and the Official Entry list will be published on **Monday, 30 June 2025 via Sportity**.

2. The maximum number of starters in the event, including the support race, cannot exceed 140 (Art. 7.3.4 of the Sporting Regulations). As the current total number of submitted entries across all categories exceeds this limit, it is essential to note that more than 20 drivers may not be included in the Final Entry Lists.

3. Acceptance of entries will be decided by each organiser, but priority will be given by category, and entries will be selected and validated according to the order of priorities listed in Art. 7.1.5 of the Sporting Regulations.

4. The Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse the entry of a Competitor or a Driver, giving the reason for such refusal, with respect of priorities specified in Art. 7.1.5. of the Sporting Regulations (Art. 7.3.1 of the Sporting Regulations).

5. The priorities indicated in the "Priority" column are reviewed on 30 June 2025, following the results of Round 4 in Matschenberg.
