



FINAL INSTRUCTION 1

Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry to the Clare Stages Forestry Rally 2024. The seeded entry list is available on the Sportity App.

We extend our thanks to our sponsors M Fitzgibbon Contractors & Sheil's Motor Group. We thank Coillte for the use of their Forestry. We also extend our gratitude to the local businesses and residents of Scariff town and surrounding areas.

The event will be promoting the Motorsport Ireland "Keep Race in its Place" initiative for the weekend and we ask that everyone respect the rules of the road and protect the sport.

GARDA SPEED CHECKS WILL BE ENFORCED THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND

1. Sportity App: The organisers are using the Sportity App to assist competitors to easily access all documentation relating to the rally including Regulations, Final Instructions, Start Lists, Competitor Bulletins etc. You will receive a push notification on your phone when any new information is published. **Sportity App Password: SCARIFF24**

2. Entries / Documentation: Please note that IRDS/BRDS insurance will only apply for the Rally Route and the Parc Ferme Route & Scrutiny as detailed in the event road book.

3. Competitor arrival: When you arrive in Scariff, please make your way to the Service Park with your car and trailer. **Service Park will be open from 12pm 04OCT2024.** You will be advised where trailer park is located in the Service area. Please only use the access lane directly beside the Garda station at all times over the weekend. Service is strictly a one way system. **Please be mindful that the service area is a working area until 5pm Friday evening.**

Parking of trailers and competitor vehicles is strictly forbidden in and around the main town of Scariff and Rally HQ on Friday & Saturday to avoid congestion for local traffic. **Trailers are not**

allowed in the vicinity of the Scrutiny location. Competitors are asked to park their own trailers in the trailer park.

4. Trailer Park: A Trailer Park is located at an area in the service park; you will be advised of this location on arrival.

5. Scrutineering: Due to a large entry, Mechanical Scrutineering will commence at an earlier time of 15:00 hrs at the Scariff Rugby Club V94 R5X9. PLEASE NOTE AMENDED START TIME. SCRUTINY WILL FINISH AT 8PM SHARP. Due to the large entry and club commitments we ask you all to please arrive early to assist with this time schedule. Scrutineers have reported that in recent events, very few competitors arrive during the first two hours and then a queue had to be managed near finishing time. Trackers and Competition Numbers will be available at the scrutiny venue from 12.45 pm. Please present cars ready for scrutineering in accordance with Appendices 2, 25, 29 & 29.1 of the Motorsport Ireland Yearbook 2024, with decals attached, the scrutiny sheet signed by the driver and all other relevant documentation provided. The Safety Tracker System must be fitted prior to Scrutineering. A secure pre-event Parc Fermé will be located adjacent to the service park. Competition cars must be placed in Parc Fermé no later than 30 mins following completion of mechanical scrutineering. Please follow marshal instructions regarding parking of cars in Parc Ferme. Paper Scrutiny should be done promptly as the rally office is closing at 8:30pm sharp. **Ensure that you signed on for IRDS at Service area (ensure you have a road book) before you bring the competition car on to the public road. The driving of competing cars outside of the specified route as laid out in the road book may lead to exclusion. Only the named driver is covered by IRDS at any time and only while travelling on the rally route, as specified in the road book. IRDS insurance does not extend to service crews.**

6. Safety Tracking System: A Safety Tracking System will operate at the rally. Collection, installation and operation of the system are advised in a separate Information bulletin. The Safety Tracking System must be fitted to the car before Scrutineering.

7. Rally Start: Each crew member MUST attend the Competitors Safety Briefing at 8:00am on Saturday 5th October at Rally HQ (Scariff GAA Complex V94 CA47). This applies to junior entrants also.

8. Time Cards: PLEASE NOTE: Time Cards will be handed out prior to Drivers Briefing once full crew attendance is confirmed. Please ensure that you bring your competition licence for both Driver and Navigator for identification purposes. Please aim to be at Drivers Briefing at 7.15am to ensure that all Competitors are in the hall at 8am. **All competitors must be in place to enable the Briefing to start at 8am.** Non-attendance at drivers briefing will lead to exclusion, with the entry fee being non-refundable. A random roll call will take place to ensure attendance throughout the briefing. The rally will start from Control A at Parc Fermé Out.

9. Juniors: Competitors in class 21 will compete on all stages. These competitors – both driver and navigator must attend Driver's Briefing at 8am in rally HQ.

10. Service: Service Stickers will be supplied in the Competitor's Pack at Documentation Scrutiny. The Service Area is located at EKO integrated services. The Service Area will open on Friday the 4th from 12pm to 8pm and on Saturday 5th from 6.30am. There is ample parking in the area around the

service area for personal cars. Access to the Service Area will be from 6.30am Saturday and is restricted to authorised service vehicles and competition cars only. Where multiple cars are being serviced from the one service vehicle, it is advisable to contact the Service Area Manager, Pat Malone (086) 2552783 to arrange your location. One service sticker will be issued to each competition car to allow access to service. This sticker must be physically stuck on the vehicle. Please Note: A 5m x 4m ground sheet must be used for servicing and any oil spills must be cleaned up promptly. All waste must be disposed of in bins provided. Please familiarise yourself with the fire requirements for the Service Area as per Appendix 25, Article 2.10.2 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook. Smoking is not permitted within the Service Area. Please exercise caution when refuelling or performing any works that involve heat generation while servicing. Refer to the Event Regulations, Article 9 Servicing. All service crews are requested to have fire extinguishers clearly disabled.

11. Rally Finish: After stage 6 all competition cars will be returning to Parc Ferme as per road book. Competitors must proceed directly to Parc Fermé as directed by marshals and remain there for 30 minutes as per Article 3.9 of Appendix 25 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook. Provisional Results will be posted on the Official Notice Board and on the Sportity App.

Selected cars will be brought to the finish ramp which will be located at Rally HQ
