## **12.6 STARTING SYSTEM OF SPECIAL STAGES**

Notwithstanding 2022 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations Art. 41.3.1, all competitors will drive with 2' intervals on all special stages except on the Power Stage.

# 12.6.1 OKAZAKI CITY SUPER SPECIAL STAGE

Fitting of extra lights carried in the rally car is allowed in the regroup 12A/13. Only tools carried in the rally car may be used.

## 12.14 CONTROL PROCEDURES AND TIME CARD HANDLING

#### Flexi Service C and F – 45 minutes, replace point a) with the following:

a) P1 crews: After the 10-minute Technical Zone, P1 crews will check-in at TC *Parc Fermé OUT & Flexi* Service IN at their due time and drive their cars into their service bays where the start of the allowed 45minute service time will be controlled by rally officials. TC *Flexi service OUT/ Parc Fermé IN* is at the overnight parc fermé entrance, where the end time of the service is recorded.

#### 12.15 MEDIA ZONES (new article)

All priority drivers (and co-drivers upon request) must be available for media interviews for a minimum of 15 minutes or until they are given permission to leave by the FIA Media Delegate.

The Media Zone will be operational as follows: **TC4A**, **TC7A**, **TC10A**, **TC14A**, **TC19A**.

Access to the Media Zone is restricted to the following:

- 1. Accredited media or team media personnel holding a green pass
- 2. Team principals or team representatives, who are, in view of the FIA Media Delegate, performing media duties and displaying a Media Zone sticker issued by the FIA Media Delegate for this event on their pass.
- 3. Holders of a red All Access pass

Media Zone sticker requests should be sent by email to: vdussausaye@fia.com.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Media Zone will no longer be divided into two separate zones (Zone 1 and Zone 2). However, an interview area complete with branded backdrops will still be arranged and all priority drivers (and co-drivers upon request) are required to report to this area on arrival in the Media Zone without delay for interviews with broadcast media.

Non-broadcast media will be able to access this area but are also permitted to conduct interviews in close proximity to the cars, depending on sufficient time being available.

Accredited media will be advised to respect personal space when interviewing drivers/team principals and will be encouraged to use recording equipment on extension poles or in fixed positions. In addition, accredited media will be reminded that Rally1 cars can be hard to hear when starting/moving.

No other personnel will be allowed in the Media Zone unless authorised by the FIA Media Delegate and holding the correct pass.

#### 12.16 SERVICE PARK (new article)

Due to promotion activities and spectator movements in the Service Park, P1 and WRC2 teams are forbidden to dismantle any external structures or banners in their service area until 15:00 on Sunday, November 13. There should be no movement of vehicles or dismantling operations outside the boundaries of each team service area until this point. In case of early retirement from the event team representatives should contact the Clerk of Course.
