The Stewards, having received a report from the FIA Deputy Technical Delegate, summoned the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Facts** On Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September at TC 6C (Parc Ferme IN) Car No. 31 was found without the mandatory HANKOOK stickers on the rear bumper.

**Offence** Breach of Articles 29.5.1 and 29.5.2 of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations in conjunction with Article 6.3 and Appendix 4 of the Supplementary Regulations of Rally Chile BioBío 2025.

**Decision** (1) To impose a **Fine of € 1000** on the Competitor of Car No. 31 MARTÍN SCUNCIO  
(2) The Competitor is requested not to publish neither on web nor on any social media the picture or video of car No. 31 taken during Rally Chile BioBío 2025 without the mandatory stickers.

**Reason** A hearing was held on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> September at 14.45 hrs with the Team Manager of Competitor of car No. 31, Mr. Javier Scuncio.

The Competitor's representative stated that his crew had an incident on Friday afternoon, due to which the rear bumper was damaged.

Once the car arrived at Flexi Service B, the new bumper was installed, and Mr. Javier Scuncio asked the Competitors' Relations Officer to receive a spare kit of stickers. The spare stickers were delivered to the team when car No. 31 was already in Parc Fermé, so it was not possible for them to apply the new Hankook stickers on the rear bumper of their car.

After the hearing the Stewards contacted the Competitors' Relations Officer Mr. Javier Igleis, who showed the message received from Mr. Scuncio at 20.15 hrs on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2025 with the request of the spare stickers.

As the car entered Flexi Service B (TC6B) at 19.45 hrs on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2025, it is clear that the request for a new kit of stickers was made late. Furthermore, the FIA Deputy Technical Delegate reported to the Stewards that a verbal reminder was given to the Competitor of car No. 31 at TC6A (Technical Zone IN).

It is also to be considered that car No. 31 ran the first loop of the Special Stages on Saturday morning without the stickers applied, even though the crew had been provided with the stickers prior to the car leaving the Parc Fermé.

The Stewards concluded that this incident had a negative impact on the commercial rights of the WRC, therefore the fine imposed is appropriate in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the 2025 FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
