Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations of the Rally

7. TYRES

7.1. Tyres specified for use during the rally (amend)

7.2. Tyre quantities for use during the rally (amend)

The maximum number of tyres for the rally (including shakedown) is 28 for Rally1 cars, 30 for Rally2 cars and 26 for all other cars. In accordance with Art. 13.2.5 of the 2025 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations the maximum number of tyres of the alternative choice for all cars in class RC1 is either ~~12~~ **16** or **20** and for all other 4WD cars either 8 or 12.

The FIA must be notified at wrc-technical@fia.com before the start of the Shakedown (Thursday, 11 September 2025, 8:56 hrs) of the number of tyres of the alternative choice that the competitor wishes to use (~~P1 competitors must notify of their choice by Tuesday, 9 September 2025, 18:00 hrs~~). Alternative compound tyres are not required to be used in the Shakedown.

This choice neither increases nor decreases the maximum number of tyres for the rally. If the competitor wishes to have ~~12~~ **16** (or ~~16~~ **20** for RC1) alternative compound tyres for use in the rally instead of 8 (or 12 for ~~RC1~~ **RC2 and RC3**), the number of tyres of the first choice will automatically be reduced by 4 tyres.
