1 Rally Site Exploration

Competitors are reminded that the rally is taking place on private property which was formerly a copper mine and sulfuric acid plant. Mining operations date back to the late 1800s, and due to the long period of time this location was used for industrial purposes, there may be unknown/unmapped dangers on the property outside of designated areas. These include but are not limited to: abandoned buildings, dangerous debris from previous site demolitions, acidic water, and open mine shafts.

Competitors and crew are not permitted free reign over the site during the event. The roads and runoff areas have been chosen to minimize exposure to hazards.

Please observe the following guidance:

- Do not leave the roads/areas designated for use during the rally.
 - o "Designated for use" is defined as a location that is explicitly called out in the Supplemental Regulations, an official Bulletin, a Clerk of the Course Communication, or as part of the official route in the Route Book.
- Do not attempt to shortcut across the property (even on foot).
- Do not bring off-leash pets that may wander out of sight.
