All Competitors / crew members

The Stewards, having received a report from the Clerk of the Course with documentary evidence attached, summoned the above crew members as well as a competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Facts Failure by the crew addressed above to activate the OK display on the FIA Safety tracking device within one minute after stopping on SS18 on 21.04.2024 at 09:14 hrs.

Offence Breach of Art. 53.3.3 of the 2024 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

Decision Having considered that Mr. LAURI JOONA is a FIA priority 2 driver, Driver LAURI JOONA and Co-driver JANNI HUSSI shall be jointly and severally liable to pay a **fine of € 1000.**

In accordance with Art. 12.8 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code, fines shall be paid within 48 hours of their notification. Any delay in making payment may entail Suspension during the period a fine remains unpaid.

Reason The crew was informed accordingly by the Stewards and was given the possibility, if they wished, to bring forward any representations other than having forgotten to activate the OK display within one minute in the heat of the moment.

The crew confirmed that they did not want to make any further representations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the 2024 FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules.
