Subject: RallySafe Equipment Installation for RallySafe events

Issue Date: March 5, 2026

Competing cars are required to arrive at technical inspection fully fitted to accept a RallySafe unit. This means that the external antenna, internal antenna, power lead, ram mount, and connector arms must be in the car and in good, functioning condition. Teams should inspect **all** components for damage from accidents, regular wear, or unintentional abuse. This includes broken housings, frayed or stripped wires, broken or stripped connectors, and broken pins in the power lead connector.

Antenna wires should also be inspected to ensure that any extra length of wire is not bundled in a 'loop' but is run back and forth across the car as shown in the installation instructions - **this is crucial for satellite communication**. Teams are encouraged to check these items at least a month before their next event to ensure sufficient delivery time for replacement parts from Australia, as CARS does not carry inventory of RallySafe supplies.
