1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The DresdenCup will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, and the relevant ISU Communications.

The categories Juvenile and Non-ISU Basic Novice will be according to the rules of the ISU for Basic Novice and the specific regulations contained in this announcement. The Well Balanced Program for Adult will be according to the ISU Technical Requirements for Adult.

Participation in the DresdenCup is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in this announcement and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

2. **TECHNICAL DATA**

PLACE Main arena: JOYNEXT Arena, Magdeburger Straße 10, 01067 Dresden, Germany

(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

Practice arena: JOYNEXT Arena, Magdeburger Straße 10, 01067 Dresden, Germany

(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

Main and Practice Rink are in the same complex / building.

JUVENILE Team shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four)

alternate skaters. All skaters must have not reached the age of 13

before July 1, 2024*.

Free Skating 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

Maximum level to be called will be level 2 for element and features.

except SySp max. will be level 1 according to the current WBP

communication.

NON ISU Team shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) **BASIC NOVICE**

alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of

10, but not have reached the age of 16 before July 1, 2024*.

Free Skating Free Skating: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

MIXED AGE Team shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four)

alternate skaters. No age limit.

Free Skating 3.30 min (+ / - 10 sec)

ADULT Team shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four)

alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of

21 before July 1, 2024*.

Free Skating 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)





* Age requirements: 75% of the team must fulfill the age requirement corresponding to the category. For the other 25% an age deviation of +/-2 years is permitted for the categories Juvenile and Non-ISU Basic Novice, and an age deviation of -3 years is permitted for the Adult category. The 75% / 25% rule applies according to the number of skaters which are skating the free skating.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 General

All entries have to be sent to the Organizing Committee (OC) of the DresdenCup 2025.

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of teams per country or to refuse participation if the maximum number of teams that can take part in the competition is reached.

3.2 Preliminary Entries

The preliminary entry form must be submitted no later than October 1st, 2024.

After the deadline of the pre-registration the Team Managers of the registered teams will receive an e-mail with a link for the final registration forms.

3.3 Final Entry

3.3.1 Entries of Teams

All final entries and nominations must be submitted to the OC no later than Friday, November 1, 2024.





3.3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge for Synchronized Skating. The Entries of Judges must be made via e-mail to <u>info@dresdencup.eu</u> and reach the OC, not later than **Friday, November 1, 2024**.

The Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be nominated by the Organizing Committee. Expenses for travel, accommodation and meals for Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be covered by the OC.

The transportation to the official hotel is offered to Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators and Judges. All Officials are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible the name of the airline, flight number, date and time of arrival or any other information concerning transportation and arrival.

3.3.3 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

The names of all team members must be submitted and must reach the Organizing Committee not later than: **Friday, November 1, 2024**.

3.3.4 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

600.00 € per Team

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

Please note, the transfer of the entry fee is due without further invoice. The entry fee payment does not include any extra practice ice nor any offered meals at the competition.

The payment of the entry fee must be done no later than Friday, November 1, 2024.

4. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators and Judges participating, beginning with dinner on **Saturday**, **January 25**, **2025**, until breakfast on **Monday**, **January 27**, **2025**.

Should any of the above-mentioned persons arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators.



5. PRACTICE

The official practice will start on Sunday, January 26, 2025 approximately 07.00 a.m. For each competing Team a 10 minutes practice ice session will be provided for the categories Juvenile, Basic Novice and Adult. For Mixed Age category will be a 11 minutes practice ice session.

Unofficial Extra Practice

Extra practice ice will only be available on request on Wednesday and Thursday.

If you require extra practice ice, please make your reservation no later than December 20, 2024. We kindly ask you to send your preferred time slots to the OC via e-mail info@dresdencup.eu

6. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 823 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating, the team music shall be submitted to the OC as follows:

All teams shall furnish competition music of excellent quality as MP3 or M4A file format via e-mail to info@dresdencup.eu. The respective e-mail should only contain one music file. The subject of the e-mail and the file must be clearly indicated and labeled in the following format:

<Category>_<Nation>_<Team Name>_<Segment: SP or FS>_<Running Time> Example:

Music files are requested to be uploaded no later than Friday, November 1, 2024.

Additionally, each team shall bring their competition music on a clearly labeled USB drive as a backup. One USB drive for each program. The music must be submitted by the Team Manager or Team Leader at the time of registration. All music must be clearly indicated with the name of the team and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time). The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must all be listed for each team on the Official Music and Press Information Form in the ISU Portal. The Planned Program Content must be entered by the teams in the ISU Portal. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. The Planned Program Content must be entered with the final entry date.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

7. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The nearest airport to **Dresden** is **Dresden International Airport (DRS)** with a distance of **10 km** to the official hotel.

The Organizing Committee provides a bus shuttle to meet the teams on arrival. Please accept that we have to ask for a small transportation fee from all persons using the shuttle service. Please inform the Local Organizing Committee together with your entry whether you will be using the transportation offered.

9. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the Joynext Arena, Friday, January 24, 2025 from 9:00 am to 06:00 pm and on Saturday, January 25, 2025 from 9:00 am until the end of competition day.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and Team Leaders (1 per country), Team Managers (1 per Team), Official Coaches (2 per Team), Team Medical Persons (1 Team Doctor and 1 Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff – OC will request a certificate prior to accreditation) Team Service Staff (2 per Team).

All team members will need to identify themselves by a passport or an identity card when registering at the event. Copies have to be collected for the Referee of the competition.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests.

10. DRAW

The official draws for the competition will be done electronically and take place on Thursday, January 23, 2025. The starting order will be published on the competition website after the draw.



11. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Synchronized Skating 2024, Rule 842 and Rule 843 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

12. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES

The three best placed Teams in each event will be announced and honored. A trophy will be presented to the winning team in each category. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists.

All participants will receive a digital certificate of participation via e-mail after the competition.

13. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The ISU and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

14. PUBLICITY WAIVER

Each individual / team waives any and all rights to financial remuneration or other compensation for the use and reproduction of their image or likeness, and grants permission to use the same prior to, during and following the DresdenCup 2025 in Dresden, Germany.

15. MEETINGS FOR ISU EVENT OFFICIALS AND JUDGES

All Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and Judges are responsible to make their travel arrangements in order to be able to attend the respective event related meetings. If any other party makes the flight arrangements, the Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and the Judges are responsible to check if such arrangements are in line with the detailed schedule as mentioned under paragraph 17.

16. INFORMATION AND VARIOUS

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the competition after the closing date if restrictions imposed by the public health authorities or government regulations prohibit or make it untenable to hold the competition. In this case, the OC will refund 90 percent of the entry fee.
