

**2024 Wild West Regional Rally
Recce Instructions, Version 2
Sat, 9 Mar**



General Information

Recce for the Wild West Rally will be by caravan on the Brooklyn and Smith Creek stage roads. We understand that this is not ideal. The reason for this is that two of the three stage roads are run in both directions, each of these roads have spots where two-way recce traffic would require traffic control, and there are no roads that can be used to bypass these stage roads in a reasonable amount of time (e.g., to allow for open recce in one direction and then open recce in the other later in the day).

Recce on the Palix stage road is open. Competitors are reminded that, per RCR 1.2.1.d, stage roads may only be driven in the stage direction during recce.

The recce caravan will start with a lead vehicle and end with a sweep vehicle. The recce caravan will depart Willapa Harbor Skate Park at 434 8th St. in Raymond at approximately 1000.

When starting recce of each stage road, it is recommended that competitors in this event start approximately 30 seconds after the car preceding them.

Competitors are reminded that recce takes place on open, public roads. There could be oncoming traffic at any time. Be courteous to non-rally traffic.

Enforceable Amendment to the Supplementary Regulations

1. Recce will be held on Sat, 9 Mar. It will nominally start at 1000 and end at 1800, however driving the Brooklyn or Smith Creek any stage road during this time but outside of the recce caravan may be considered "practicing" per RCR 6.9.
2. Vehicles used for recce by competitors in this event must have their entered car number prominently displayed on the vehicle's front and rear. Failure to do so may result in exclusion from the event.
3. The speed limit on all stage roads during recce is 25 mph.
4. Some rally officials will be driving in the recce caravan and others will be on the rally route doing set-up. Rally officials that observe recce will be considered Judges of Fact concerning the behavior of competitors during recce.
5. While doing recce of any stage road, competitors in this event must not slow enough to delay the car behind them. Depending on the circumstances, doing so may be considered an infraction per RCR 1.2.1.g.

Late Arrival

Competitors for this event that arrive after the recce caravan has left Willapa Harbor Skate Park may join the caravan later in the day. They must first contact the event registrar, receive their competitor packet (including the route book), and then find the caravan.

Despite some stage roads being the most direct route between some points, competitors in this event who are trying to join the recce caravan late or leave the caravan early are reminded to not drive any stage road outside of the recce caravan.

Here are the approximate start times for various points along the Recce Route. These are not check-in times; they are intended as guidance to help figure out where to join the recce caravan after it has departed from Willapa Harbor Skate Park. Depending on the number of cars in the caravan, there will be a 20-30 minute window after the start of each stage road to join the caravan.

Directions from Competitor Check-in to Brooklyn W

Go to US-101 and turn right (north) towards Aberdeen (17.7 miles), turn onto WA-107 towards Montesano (8.2 miles), turn onto US-12 towards Elma/Olympia (10.1 miles), exit the highway to stay on US-12 towards Oakville (13.9 miles), right onto State St (1.9 miles), left onto Garrard Creek (3.5 miles), straight/right onto Brooklyn Rd (3.2 miles). Continue onto the Brooklyn W stage road.

Brooklyn W ATC: 46.801145, -123.344670

75 min, 60 miles.

Directions from Competitor Check-in to Smith Creek W or Brooklyn E

Go to US-101 and turn right (north) towards Aberdeen (15.2 miles), turn right onto North River Rd. At 14.6 miles, turn right onto Smith Creek Rd and continue to the Smith Creek W stage road.

Brooklyn E ATC: 46.777209, -123.460828

40 min, 30 miles.

Or, at 18.6 miles, continue straight to the Brooklyn stage road.

Smith Creek W ATC: 46.785847, -123.539303

50 min, 34 miles.

Directions from Competitor Check-in to Smith Creek E

Go to US-101 and turn right (north) towards Aberdeen (1.6 miles), turn right onto Butte Creek Rd (3.1 miles), stay on the road as it merges with Smith Creek Rd (4.6 miles), and continue to the Smith Creek E stage road.

Smith Creek E ATC: 46.759148, -123.635857

15 min, 10 miles.
