EUROPEAN INLINE FREESTYLE SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

2023



Dear President,

We are honoured to inform you that World Skate Europe has decided that the European Inline Freestyle Skating Championship 2023 (EIFSC), will be held in Ciudad Real (Spain) on 1-3 September 2023.

EVENT DETAILS:

- Venue: Pabellón Quijote Arena (Calle Juan Ramón Jiménez, 4, 13005 Ciudad Real)

- Date: 1 - 3 September 2023
- Skating Disciplines: Freestyle Slalom Classic, Freestyle Slalom Pair, Freestyle Slalom Battle, Speed Slalom, Freestyle Slide, Jump, Speed Slalom Team.

COMPETITION STRUCTURE AND RULES:

1. Categories:

- Freestyle Slalom Classic: Men, Women, Junior Men, Junior Women.
- Freestyle Slalom Pair: (common category without gender and age division).
- Freestyle Slalom Battle: Men, Women, Junior Men, Junior Women.
- Speed Slalom: Men, Women, Junior Men, Junior Women.
- Freestyle Slide: Men, Women (juniors compete with seniors).
- Jump: Men, Women (juniors compete with seniors).
- Team Speed Slalom: Men, Women (juniors compete with seniors).

Junior category is from 10 to 18 years old. The minimum age for competing at the European Championship is 10. The age refers to the age of the skater is turning in the year of the competition.

(The organization will check all athletes' passports or ID at registration process to validate the category of each skater.)

METHOD OF PARTICIPATION:

WS affiliated associations can present a team to represent a country. Every team will have a maximum of 6 representatives for discipline, gender and category.

Green Card: this is only applicable to skaters who are in the WS Top 20 ranking (Top 10 ranking for Freestyle Slide, Freestyle Slalom Pair and Jump). Each country, through its National Skating Federation, can register up to 2 skaters in each discipline, gender and category with the green card. Example: Country A has 4 skaters in the WS Top 20 ranking in Speed Slalom Women Junior. As a result, Country A will be allowed to register up to 8 women junior in Speed Slalom (2 green cards + 6 members).



NATIONAL TEAMS:

1. Team Managers: Each National Team shall be composed by up to:
 - a. Team Leader
 - b. Team Manager
 - c. Coach.
2. Skaters:
 - a. Speed Slalom, Freestyle Slalom Classic and Freestyle Slalom Battle: A maximum of 12 male skaters (6 for seniors and 6 for juniors) and 12 female skaters (6 for seniors and 6 for juniors) are allowed for each country for the aforementioned disciplines.
 - b. Pair Slalom: Competitors will not be classified by age or gender. Pair Slalom teams shall be composed by two members. A maximum of 3 teams are allowed for each country.
 - c. Freestyle Slides: Participants will not be classified by age. Each country may register up to 6 male and up to 6 female athletes.
 - d. Free jump: The organization will limit the registration. National Federations will register their official team, but independent skaters may be accepted
 - e. Team Speed Slalom: Competitors will not be classified by age or gender. Teams shall be composed by three members. A maximum of 2 teams are allowed for each country.

COMPETITION METHOD:

The most updated articles of World Skate Inline Freestyle Rules shall be used.

To attend the Opening Ceremony, all athletes from the same country should wear proper uniform or clothes.

Skates, pads and other equipment should be adequate for the safety of skaters.

Freestyle Slalom Classic and Freestyle Slalom Pair music must be on .mp3 format and must be submitted to the organizer at the latest on August 1st, 2023, by email. Failing to do so will result in a penalty of 10 points. Music submitted after August 1st, 2023, will not be accepted, and the competitor will not be allowed to compete. The music shall be sent to vladimir.tkachev@worldskate.org

The name of the file must match the name of the skater or the pair and the country. Example: John Doe - Spain).

The organization reserves its right not to accept the music file if it is not in a .mp3 format or its contents are not proper (i.e., bad language, explicit sexual or violent content, etc.)



RANKING AND AWARDING:

The top 6 of each category will be awarded. The top 3 of each category will be awarded with medals and certificates. The 4th to 6th places will be awarded with certificates only. If a category only has 3 countries or less, the event shall be taken only as a demonstration event and no certificate would be awarded.

ENTRIES AND FEES:

To participate on the EIFSC, skaters must pay a registration fee, which will help to cover the organisation costs. The entry fee per skater is 50€

All payments are due to World Skate Europe and must be made as following:

- All payments are made in EUROS
- All payments must be made before August 1st at 2 p.m.
- All payments are made by Bank Transfer only
- Bank Transfers are to be made without costs to World Skate Europe
- Bank Transfer Proof of payment **MUST** be sent to World Skate Europe by e-mail, to:

Failing in follow this procedure may result in not acceptance of the inscriptions and, consequently, fail to participate in the events.

WS - EFSC will follow the current WADA antidoping rules.

September 1st, 2023: Arrival and Register of National Teams
September 1st - 3rd 2023: Competition

During the EIFSC the organizer reserves its right to take audio-visual material in the competition spot and its surroundings. By giving your registration, you accept to be recorded or photographed and that these images and videos may be used in the future by WS and RFEP.
