Announcement

British Ice Skating is pleased to announce the March Qualifier for Singles and Pairs, for the 2024 British Figure Skating Championships and 2024 Novice Championships. This Qualifier will cover Basic Novice to Senior Categories in Singles and Pairs.

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the BIS Generic Criteria and all pertinent communications for Singles and Pairs. All competitors must be eligible persons in accordance with ISU Rule 102 and be a British Ice Skating Member. British Ice Skating reserve the right to restrict the number of entries accepted and may operate a waiting list, and/or to only allow 24 skaters to advance to the FP based on the results of the SP.

Skaters wishing to compete in any British Championships season must achieve qualification at one of the National Qualifier events in the season in which the Championship is being held. Skaters may only enter one level per event. Should a Skater throughout the course of the qualifiers attain the qualification requirements for the Championships in more than one level they will be required to skate in the highest level in the Championships. For example, a skater who has attained Championship qualification in both Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice will be required to skate in the Intermediate Novice Category at the Championships. Please note this does not limit or tie any skater into competing at the higher level internationally.

Senior Performance Squad members will qualify automatically for the British Championship at their level if they retain their ISU qualification score for squad in the current season, as per the selection manual.

General Regulations

Skaters competing in the singles category will follow ISU regulations including age eligibility. The competition will be conducted in accordance with the BIS Generic Criteria and all pertinent communications for Singles and Pairs and in conjunction with all BIS policies. All competitors must be eligible persons in accordance with ISU Rule 102 and must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements of the UK.

British Ice Skating reserve the right to cancel the event without liability if the Current Covid 19 situation or any other situation arises which requires this for the best interest of the skaters and officials. Please do not attend if you are unwell or have tested positive for COVID or any other contagious disease.

All Skaters with medical conditions are obliged to inform the Event Organiser of these underlying conditions in order that the medical team be fully informed. Skaters must not skate if any medical professional recommends them not to. If a medical incident occurs during the event the on-site designated first aider, referee and/or event organiser reserves the right to withdraw the skater.

Please note that following the closing date NO refunds or transfers will be issued for any reason. Withdrawals prior to the closing date will be subject to administration of £15 + stripe fees, or available as transfers only. Stripe fees cannot be refund under any circumstance. Skaters who apply but do not meet the terms of this announcement will be withdrawn and no refund will be given.

Entries of competitors must be made through the individual members portal and must contain:

- Payment
- Music Form (complete by 4th March 2024)
- PPC (complete by 19th February 2024)

Withdrawals

Withdrawals received after 2nd February 2024, will not be refunded.

Withdrawals received before the closing date will occur £25 administration fee.

If we have too many entries and cannot offer everyone a place, we will refund those who we cannot take.

All refunds will be processed in the first few weeks after the end of the event.

Any withdrawals after the official draw will need to be communicated by submitting the Withdrawal Form:

Skaters withdrawing after the official draw will need to have a valid reason and a proof (submitted via Withdrawal Form). Failure to do so might affect future entry into the event.



Draws

All Draws will take place prior to the event by electronic draw. Subsequent draws will be based on reverse order.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the organizer accepts no liability for injury or damages incurred by competitors or officials. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Anti-Doping

The Association has determined that anti-doping testing <u>may</u> be carried out at this event. British Ice Skating fully adheres to UKAD Policies.
