Announcement

British Ice Skating is pleased to announce the British Figure Skating Championships 2023. This Event will cover Advanced Novice to Senior Categories in Singles and all ISU levels in Pairs and Ice Dance.

Skaters wishing to compete in the British Figure Skating Championships 2023 must meet the minimum requirements set out in all ISU and BIS documentation in relation to this event and the qualifying events. Only invited skaters will be eligible to enter this event.

Skaters may only enter one level per event. Should a Skater throughout the course of the qualifiers attain the qualification requirements for the Championships in more than one level they will be required to skate in the highest level in the Championships. For example, a skater who has attained Championship qualification in both Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice will be required to skate in the Intermediate Novice Category at the Championships. Please note this does not limit or tie any skater into competing at the higher level internationally.

Senior Performance Squad members will qualify automatically for the British Championship at their level if they retain their ISU qualification score for squad in the current season, as per the selection manual.

Eligibility

The following requirements do not fully replicate the ISU requirements for skaters wishing to represent Great Britain Internationally. Additional criteria apply - please refer to ISU General Regulations and ISU Communications.

For legal ruling regarding British Residency and Citizenship skaters should contact the Home Office or if abroad the relevant British Consulate.

Skaters must meet the following requirements:

- BIS eligible (Full or Retained) members
- Skaters who are British citizens OR skaters who have legally resided in Great Britain or Northern Ireland for at least one year, but are citizens of another country.
- In the Pairs and Dance events, one partner of the Pair or Dance couple must be a British citizen. The other partner of the Pair or Dance couple may be a citizen or resident of another country.

General Regulations

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the Criteria and all pertinent communications for Singles and Pairs and Ice Dance.

All Skaters with medical conditions are obliged to inform the Event Organiser of these underlying conditions in order that the medical team be fully informed.

Please note that following the closing date NO refunds will be issued for any reason.

British Ice Skating reserve the right to cancel the event without liability if the Current Covid 19 situation or any other situation arises which requires this for the best interest of the skaters and officials. Please do not attend if you are unwell or have tested positive for COVID or any other contagious disease.

All Skaters with medical conditions are obliged to inform the Event Organiser of these underlying conditions in order that the medical team be fully informed.

Please note that following the closing date NO refunds or transfers will be issued for any reason. Withdrawals prior to the closing date will be subject to fees or available as transfers only. Stripe fees cannot be refund under any circumstance.

This event may be livestreamed.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the organizer accepts no liability for injury or damages incurred by competitors or officials. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Anti-Doping

The Association has determined that anti-doping testing may be carried out at this event. British Ice Skating fully adheres to UKAD Policies.
