Announcement

British Ice Skating is pleased to announce the October Qualifier for Singles and Pairs, to the 2023 British Figure Skating Championships and 2024 Novice Championships. This Qualifier will cover Basic Novice to Senior Categories in Singles and Pairs.

Skaters wishing to compete in any British Championships season must achieve qualification at one of the National Qualifier events in the season in which the Championship is being held.

Skaters may only enter one level per event. Should a Skater throughout the course of the qualifiers attain the qualification requirements for the Championships in more than one level they will be required to skate in the highest level in the Championships. For example, a skater who has attained Championship qualification in both Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice will be required to skate in the Intermediate Novice Category at the Championships. Please note this does not limit or tie any skater into competing at the higher level internationally.

Senior Performance Squad members will qualify automatically for the British Championship at their level if they retain their ISU qualification score for squad in the current season, as per the selection manual.

Skaters competing in the singles category will follow ISU regulations including age eligibility. They must hold skills, national components and national technical in follows:

- Basic Novice 4
- Intermediate Novice 5
- Advance Novice 6
- Junior 7
- Senior 8

General Regulations

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the Criteria and all pertinent communications for Singles and Pairs.

All competitors must be eligible persons in accordance with ISU Rule 102 and must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements of the UK.

British Ice Skating reserve the right to cancel the event without liability if the Current Covid 19 situation or any other situation arises which requires this for the best interest of the skaters and officials. Please do not attend if you are unwell or have tested positive for COVID or any other contagious disease.

All Skaters with medical conditions are obliged to inform the Event Organiser of these underlying conditions in order that the medical team be fully informed.

Please note that following the closing date NO refunds or transfers will be issued for any reason. Withdrawals prior to the closing date will be subject to fees or available as transfers only. Stripe fees cannot be refund under any circumstance.

Place & Date

The competition will be held in Sheffield, from 2nd-6th October 2023

All competition events will take place in Ice Sheffield.

Entries of competitors must be made through the individual members portal.

British Ice Skating reserves the right to limit the number of competitors in every category. a maximum of 24 skaters will be advanced to the Free programme of the event based on the results of the SP.

All entries must be completed through the sport80 portal and must contain :

- Completed entry form including Program Content Sheet and Music upload.
- Full Payment
- All entries must be received by the 12noon on the closing date of 25th of August 2023
