Accreditation

The official accreditation for this competition will be available at the ice rink upon arrival. This will be located at the registration desk.

Judging

This competition will be judged using the International Judging system.

Competitors and coaches are requested to read the Technical Requirements for the events carefully.

How to enter:

 Entries must be made through the official entry form which will be published at **19.00 on Friday 1 December 2023.**



- The closing date will be **17.00 on Wednesday 13 December.** (The organiser reserves the right to close entries and bring the closing date forward if the event fills up.)
- The link for the entry form will be available on Sportity and on our Guildford Open 2024 facebook page. Please note that the entry form will not go live until **19.00.**

All entries must include:

- A fully completed Entry Form (only the Entry Form submission time will count but failure to complete this accurately will result in an invalid entry)
- Full payment via PayPal or BACS (to be completed within 24 hours of the opening date/time)
- A completed Program Content Sheet (to be completed within 24 hours of the opening date/time)
- A completed Music Upload Form (to completed within 24 hours of the opening date/time)
- A copy (photo or scan) of the skater's Skate UK Passport if this their first competition and they have not passed any Skills tests. Please upload this to entry form or email this to: entriesguildford2024@gmail.com
- Please take your time filling in the Program Content Sheet and the Music Upload Form as this will not affect your entry time. Forms that are not completed accurately will not be accepted and your entry will be invalid.
- The time of entry will be based on your Entry Form only



• The Competition Committee, in consultation with the competition referee, reserve the right to limit the number of skaters in any oversubscribed categories and have the right to refuse entry without reason



- If any of the categories are oversubscribed, they may be divided by age
- Not everyone is guaranteed a place in this competition
- Skaters should apply for the category they wish to skate in and must hold the minimum test requirements for the category being entered at the closing date
- Skaters must have an up-to-date BIS membership from date of application to the event
- For Beginners to National 3, the age is calculated as at the closing date. For National 4 and above, age is calculated as at the previous 1st of July
- Skaters will be allowed to skate in ONE category only for their Free and, where applicable, their Short Program

Payment Details

- Payment must be made upon entry via PayPal and BACs. Details will be provided on the entry form. Please add your BIS membership number as a reference. Any payments not received within 24 hours of entry will make your entry invalid
- Refunds will be issued for unsuccessful applications after the closing date once the competitor lists have been published
- Please note that following the closing date NO refunds will be issued for any other reason other than unsuccessful entry due to limitation of numbers.



Entry Fees

- Single segment entry £82.00
- Short & free program segments combined entry £123.00

Music

- A link will be available for music uploads once entries are open. Please complete within 24 hours of entry. If you have entered short and free categories, please complete a separate Music Upload Form for each category, ensuring that all details are accurate
- All competitors shall provide music of excellent quality in MP3. Please name your music file with the name of the skater and category (inc. short/free) e.g., Jayne Torvill National 6 Short. Note that we will only accept music files containing a single track
- Please bring 2 copies of your music to the competition on a CD disc and a digital copy if possible (mobile phone). Once your music has been sent, we will not accept any change or substitution of music files under any circumstances.

Program Content Sheet

- A link will be available to upload Program Content Sheets once entries are open. Please complete within 24 hours of entry. If you have entered short and free categories, please complete separate Program Content Sheets for each category, ensuring that all details are accurate
- Please do not send multiple versions to Guildford Open email addresses they will not be accepted
- It is mandatory that the Planned Program Content Sheet is filled in precisely for each skater in English using the correct terminology for the elements listed in respective ISU communications.
