<b>Fact:</b>	Sealing of 3 <sup>rd</sup> engine
<b>Offence:</b>	Breach of 10.3.1 of the Sporting regulations of the FIA European Rallycross Championship.
<b>Decision:</b>	-15 championship points
<b>Reason:</b>	Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Rallycross Championship States: 10.3.1 A driver may present up to 2 (two) engines (or sets of seals) in a Championship season. Engines will be sealed and a driver may present up to 2 (two) at scrutineering during the championship year. The penalty for any breach of this rule, the use of 3 (three) or more engines Championship year, will be the deduction of 15 (fifteen) Championship points for each offence. These points will be deducted from the Championship total.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
