



1. In response to requests from competitors, in addition to refueling the competition vehicle, Service Crews may change the tires as well. Replace Bulletin 1, item 1 and Bulletin 4, items 3, 4, and 6 with the following:
 - In the Remote Refuel/Tire Change area, Service Crews will only be permitted to refuel and/or change tires on competition vehicles.
 - Any further service by Service Crews will be considered Illegal service and will be subject to penalty under RCR 6.4.6. Any other work performed on the competition vehicle must be done by the Driver and/or Co-driver.
 - Service Crews may drop off only tires, jacks, jack stands, and fuel. All other tools and parts must have been carried in the competition vehicle.
 - There are no assigned spots in the Remote Refuel area.
 - Teams responsible for marking their tires, fuel jugs, and tools. These can be dropped off in the area identified by the hatched area of the Remote Refuel Map below, located on the east side of the road.
 - Service Crews must drop off items between 10:30 and 11:30 time.
 - Service Crews must park in the area designated “Side Road For Crew Parking” in the Remote Refuel Map below. **DO NOT PARK IN THE REMOTE REFUEL/TIRE CHANGE AREA.**
 - Give right-of-way to competition vehicles transiting from Kuhnle to Schafer. Be sure to keep the road marked “To Schafer Long Start” in the Remote Refuel Map below clear when lining up to check into the Regroup Control.
 - If desired, Service Crews can return to Service between the drop off time and pick up times.
 - Service Crew exiting before the listed pick-up time should proceed to the north end of the designated “Side Road For Crew Parking” and its junction with Kelley Road and then turn Right to exit in a manner that avoid interfering with rally traffic.
 - Service crews **MUST NOT** reenter the refuel/tire change area with vehicles to pick up items until the designated pick-up time of 13:45 – 14:15.
 - Service Crews can take items back to designated “Side Road For Crew Parking” by hand prior to the pick-up time.
 - To help us try to alleviate congestion in this area, crew carpooling is encouraged.
 - A Regroup Control has been added after the refuel/tire change. You will exchange timecards here.
 - The Regroup Out control will be unmanned. We ask that you do not enter Kelley Rd until your assigned regroup out minute to avoid congestion on the public road.

2. Replace the map provided in the Service Crew Instructions and previous Bulletins with the attached Remote Refuel Map.
