Announcement / Invitation

1. General

The **Bavarian Open Competition** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Bavarian Open Competition** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Feedback Sessions supported by ISU Development Program

As part of the ISU Development Program, Advanced Novice and Junior skaters from all disciplines and their coaches are invited to sign up for individual post-competition feedback sessions, including a video analysis conducted by ISU Officials. After the discussion, each participant will receive a USB stick containing their videos for further self-evaluation. Participation is free of charge. The main arena and the practice rink are side by side in the same building with the ice surface of 60m x 30m, heated, air-conditioned and closed.

Date: **20 January – 26 January 2025**

Entries: Members of the International Skating Union and their respective Member Clubs are invited to participate in the competition.

Competitors are to be entered by their respective Member Federation. All entries to the Bavarian Open 2025 must be done through the **ISU Online Registration System (ORS)** by the **entry deadline December 20th 2024, 20:00** (local time Oberstdorf/Germany).

Entries into Pair categories are not limited. Each ISU Member may nominate up to three (3) individual skaters/Ice Dance couples except for the Advanced Novice category in Ice Dance and Intermediate Novice category in Ice Dance, in which up to four (4) couples would be accepted. The host member (Deutsche Eislauf-Union e.V.) may exceed this limit. Members are welcome to add names of substitute skaters. Due to the total number of entries in each category, the OC will decide, if and how many substitute skaters/couples can be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of entries per category. If the OC has to limit the number of entries, priority will be given to those countries that have entered a Judge. The Nation and Name of the competitor must be mentioned in the reference of your bank transfer.

Please Note: Entries can only be accepted when the Entry Fee has arrived at the Organizers account. Members concerned will receive confirmation. If late entries are accepted by the OC, a late surcharge of € 20 for Single Skaters and € 30 for Pairs/Ice Dance couples will apply.

Expenses of Competitors: The organizer will not cover any expenses of competitors.

Officials: Members are kindly requested to nominate one International/ISU Judge and/or International/ISU TS/TC Official for Figure Skating and/or Ice Dance. Judges or TS/TC Officials qualified for both disciplines are very welcome. The nomination of a substitute is appreciated, but the Organizer reserves the right to reduce the number of Judges/Technical Officials in case of too many nominations. The composition of the panels will be finalised after the Entry deadline. It will be published to the participating members in time. The organizer will cover accommodation for accepted Judges/Technical Officials. Meals are provided for them at the ice rink during the days of competition.

Time-Schedule: The competition is planned to start on Monday January 20th, 2025 and will be finished on Sunday, January 26th, 2025. A detailed Time Schedule is sent to all participating Members soon after the Entry deadline.

Accommodation: The organizer will care about the hotel arrangements for accepted Judges and Technical Officials only.

Accreditation: The official accreditation is located at the main entrance of the Ice Rink. Accreditation will be given to Competitors/Coaches, Judges, as well as to Team Officials, as long as they are officially entered through ORS.

Draws: The Initial Draws will be conducted in the ice rink the day prior to the first segment of each categorie in accordance with Rules 512 and 513. For Novice categories it might be done on the same day as the first segment. The starting order for FS/FD is the reverse order of the result of SP/RD/PD.

Results: The determination and publication of the results will be done according to ISU Technical Rules for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, Rule 352 and 353.
All relevant event information, including entry lists, results and schedules will be uploaded and updated in real-time using the Sportity App. The respective code will be shared with all participating members after the Entry deadline.

Awards: The first three placed Skaters/Couples in each discipline are awarded trophies. A special Award Ceremony Schedule will be published with the Official Time Schedule.

Liability: In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Bavarian Open 2025, to provide

medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials, and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors, Officials, or other participating persons.

Live Stream/TV: A Live Stream of the Competition is provided. By entering the competition, each person agrees on recordings and/or transmissions (e.g. via the internet, TV) of his/her/their performance, appearance, picture, voice, or other personal characteristics displayed in connection with the event, towards an unrestricted audience and without temporal or geographical limits.

Music: All competitors shall send their music to Musik@bev-eissport.de In accordance with Rule 343 all units must show the Competition event, the Competitors name, the Members name and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. All competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program.
