



Best Lap Regulations

2026 FIM SuperEnduro World Championship

1. Definition of Acerbis Best Lap

The Acerbis Best Lap competition takes place at all 7 rounds of the 2026 FIM SuperEnduro World Championship, running from 13 December 2025 until 7 March 2026. The competition applies for the Prestige, Junior, and Youth classes.

2. Who runs the competition

Sport Up Agency, the promoter of the FIM SuperEnduro World Championship, runs the competition on behalf of Acerbis.

3. How points are given

Only lap times from the main event of each class count. At every round, the rider with the fastest single lap in their class gets 1 point. The Acerbis Best Lap points are not added to competition points, they are a separate classification.

4. How the winners are decided

After Round 7, all points are added up. The rider with the most points in each class wins the Acerbis Best Lap award and is entitled to a cash prize.

5. Acerbis Best Lap cash prizes

- Prestige winner: € 1,000
- Junior winner: € 500
- Youth winner: € 500

Acerbis will pay the prizes within 20 days after the final round.

6. Extra prizes for the Junior and Youth class

At every round, the rider with the fastest lap in the Junior class and the rider with the fastest lap in the Youth class each get a €150 Acerbis voucher.

7. Ties

Ties are broken in this order:

- a) The rider with more round wins.
- b) If still tied, the rider who finished higher in the final round.

8. Final results

Only official timing is used as provided by Motoresults. All results based on official timing are final.
