4. TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

Detailed information about **motorcycles** and **tyre specifications** can be found in the **FIM SuperEnduro World Championship & Cup Regulations 2026**.

Environmental Mat:

For all categories, when bikes are placed in the pits or in the paddock area, the use of an **Environmental Mat** is compulsory. It must be used whenever working on or parking the bikes, during practice and racing.

Warm-up:

Riders are allowed to warm-up their motorcycles and do warm-up routines on motorcycles only in any designated area. It is expressly forbidden to ride on any part of the car parks, public areas, or green, grassy or natural areas. The rider at fault shall be held responsible for any damage to a third-party property. **Riders will be shown a warm-up area on arrival at Signing On (Welcome Center).**

5. ADMINISTRATION AND TECHNICAL CONTROL:

Timetable for the FIM SuperEnduro World Championship:

Friday 27th February:

17:30 – 19:30 - **Administration control**

18:00 – 20:00 - **Technical control**

THERE IS NO ADMIN CONTROL OR TECHNICAL CONTROL ON SATURDAY MORNING

Saturday 28th February:

09:30 – 10:00 – Riders Briefing located in the **third floor** meeting room.

Full schedule of the event can be found in the **Sportity app** and **Supplementary Regulation**. A list will also be placed on the rider's information boards within the Event Control Area (Technical Control) inside the Arena.

Administration control:

The Administration control will take place in the room marked on the attached map as the **Event Secretariat, FASTEDDY EVENTS (Administration Control)**

During the **Administration control** riders are required to present their **valid licence**.

ACU UK NATIONAL EVENT:

All riders must have a valid:

ACU Licence or SACU Licence

One Day Event Licenses will not be available for this event.

During the **Administration control** each rider will receive **3 wristbands** (1 for rider and 2 for mechanics/companions). The motorcycles must be equipped with a transponder provided by the time-keeping company of the event.

Transponders:

Transponders can be collected during Administration Control. The transponder will be given to the rider for the chronometric records against a returnable deposit of **€ 100**. The transponder must be fixed to the motorcycle in the position and orientation as shown in the timekeeping information given to riders.

The loss of the transponder during the event will result in a fine of **€ 250** to be paid on the spot. The rider is the sole person responsible for the transponder

Technical control:

The Technical control will take place in the Event Control Area inside the Arena, marked on the attached map as the **Event Control Area (Technical Control)**

Riders' briefing:

The Riders' briefing will take place at **09:30am on 28th February** - before the start of the practice, in the room noted on the attached map as the **Press Conference / Briefing room, upstairs on the 3rd Floor**.

Only persons holding FIM licences, and riders in the ACU UK National event can attend this meeting, at the discretion of the FIM Referee and FIM Championship Manager.

A rider not present at the riders' briefing meeting will be fined **€ 50**, which will be collected by an FIM official and remitted to the FIM.

At each meeting with the riders at each event, the Promoter will provide a list of participants, which the participants are obliged to sign to indicate their presence.

Paddock:

There is a Riders vehicle Paddock located in the rear car parking area of the Arena (marked on the attached photo as "**To Paddock**").

Access to this vehicle Paddock is past a controlled admin area. Only vehicles belonging to riders and Teams will be allowed access. NOTE: there is NO VEHICLE PARKING ALLOWED WITHIN THE SECURE COMPUND AREA OF THE ARENA. SEWC riders will have a bike paddock in the Event Control area inside the Arena.

This is a secure area; no vehicles are allowed access inside the Arena at any time. Motorcycles may be left overnight in this SEWC bike paddock area.

All controlled areas are not accessible without wristbands. This means that accompanying persons without wristbands are not allowed in any controlled area. Arena Security Staff will be on duty, and will check all wristbands at all times.

During the races, only competitors are on the course and people with wristbands are allowed in the signal area or in the area designated by the organizer in the stands.

There is a mechanics/assistants signal zone clearly fenced and marked in the Arena area. Only those with correct wristbands will be allowed access. (2 extra given during the Administrative Control) marked on the map as **Mechanics Area** – (note it is not scale).

Parking:

Parking for all event attendees is in the main car park to the rear of the Arena area, accessed and controlled by the Fast Eddy Events admin control area.

This car park is open during the following hours:

Friday: 12:00-22:00

Saturday: 7:00-23:00

Any specific parking instructions will be given at the admin control area. All instructions and orders given by Fast Eddy Staff must be followed.

Where can I find all the most important information?

Can I buy tickets for my family/friends?

The UK round of the FIM SuperEnduro World Championship is completely sold out.

Can I buy paddock entry wristbands for my family/friends?

NO - It is not possible to buy additional wristbands in Newcastle.

By when do I have to leave the arena?

The arena must be left maximum by 2 hours after the end of the competition.

Are there showers and toilets available for the riders?

There are toilets available for the riders but no showers- they are located in all around the ground floor of the Arena.

Can I come in a camper van? If so, will there be a power/water connection?

Yes but only outside and it will be pretty cold. There is no possibility to be connected to the power/water. Please park as directed by Fast Eddy Staff and make sure that you have provided your vehicle registration to avoid parking charges.

Can I buy hot food at the arena?

Yes, but only fast food and only during the event, however please be aware that access to the food vendors is difficult from the Event Control Area due to their location in the Arena public areas..

Where can I leave my fuel?

The refueling area is clearly marked and located outside the event Control Area- you can leave your cans there, and all refueling must only take place there.

Are there seats in the spectator area provided for mechanics?

There is a particular area for mechanics/assistants with wristbands (2 extra given during the Administrative Control) marked on the map as Mechanics area.

What should I do in case of an accident?

In the case of an accident, please contact the on-site Medical Staff.

Other instructions in the case of an accident can be found in the Technical rules. Any injury incident on track will be dealt with automatically by the event staff and event medical teams.
