



## Recce Guide

### Review

Please review section 9.1 and 9.2 for the Supplementary Regulations and Bulletin 2.

### Passes

Competitors are reminded that only two passes are allowed on each stage.

### Times

Stages are open from Recce 6:30 – 16:00 on Friday June 14<sup>th</sup>. No other Recce is allowed

### RallySafe Lite

Is required to be in place for all competitors at all times(including transits) during recce.

### Speeding

Recce speed limit is 30 mph. Note the additional local regulations as documented in the Supplementary Regulations, section 9.2

Ample time is in the schedule to perform recce. This is on a non championship event and part of the goals here is to show the local officials that we can put on a safe and responsible event. Please watch your speed both on stages and the normal roads.

### Stage Access

Competitors are reminded that all stages are open during recce. We will also have volunteers on the stage setting up banner tape and other items to prepare for race day. Competitors should be prepared to encounter two-way traffic at any time.

### Recommended Route Planning

NOTE: Sina Branch Rd is under construction and should not be used to get back to the start of the Sawmill Rd stage.

### Starr Mountain

The route book is not the most efficient path back to start. Following google maps directions avoiding Dry Creek Road will save significant time for the second pass of the stage. This is summarized below:

- After the stage turn left on TN-315 N
- Proceed for ~9.8 miles
- Turn left on TN-39 W
- Proceed for ~2.3 miles
- Turn left on the access road for the stage Forest Rd 297
