4.5 Refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full only:

- To participants whose entry has been rejected
- To participants who withdraw their entry up to the closing date for entries or earlier.
- In the case of the rally not taking place

Organizers may refund 30% of the entry fee to those competitors who withdraw their entry less than 14 days before the closing date for entries, or who were unable to start the rally, if the ARA certifies a reason of “force majeure”.

Competitors may revise or withdraw their entry prior to the closing date by completing an entry update/withdrawal form available in the Registrar Folder on the Sportity App. Once entries close withdrawals and entry revisions are actioned by filing an inquiry and following RCR 4.11

9.1 - This is Recce Section

All crews taking part in the reconnaissance must register at the Rally Secretariat to get all the necessary documentation before starting reconnaissance. Registration for reconnaissance can be completed according to the following schedule:

Thursday June 13 th	12:00 – 20:00
Friday June 14 th	06:00 – 10:00

The reconnaissance ID sticker supplied during registration must be attached onto the reconnaissance car on the inside of the windshield (co-driver’s side) and must be visible for the duration of the reconnaissance period.

Please contact the Rally Secretary to request a scrutineering appointment, before the start of administrative checks.

11.3 Installation of Safety Tracking System

All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the ARA Safety Emergency Console System. The system will be installed during scrutineering. Systems may be collected either by the crew or a representative as per the schedule in Article 3. No deposit will be collected for the rally safety tracking equipment, but all the damage caused will be invoiced by the ARA afterwards.

For installation and operating instructions see Appendix 6.

The ARA Safety Emergency Console System devices must be removed at the Ceremonial Finish and must be returned no later than 23:30 on Saturday, June 15th, 2024 to the on site Rally USA representative. Vehicles that DNF can return their system to the Secretariat on Saturday at Polk County High School, before the first car arrives at TC 8A.

12.3 Drivers' & Codrivers' Meeting

All drivers / co-drivers are required to attend a Meeting at the Ceremonial Start on Friday June 14th, 2024 at 18:00. Special procedures and safety related issues will be addressed at this meeting.

12.4 Ceremonial Start Procedure and Order

The Ceremonial Start will take place at Miller Plaza on Friday June 14th, 2024, at 18:30. All cars must be inside the Parc Exposé area by 17:30. The start order for the ceremonial start will be at the discretion of the organizers in the interest of spectators and media.

The start order of the competitive element of the rally (Section 1) will be as per 2024 ARA RCR 9.2. All Competitors can trailer their rally vehicles to Polk County for the start of TCO.

12.5 Finish Procedure

The rally will end at Time Control 8A (End of Rally). After the control competitors are to proceed to the Chattanooga Choo Choo with their competition vehicles. Competitors are permitted to trailer their vehicles from Polk County to Chattanooga and unload them at the Friday Secretariat location if they desire. All Competitors who finish the rally need to report to the Chattanooga Choo Choo no later than 20:00.

Competitors that finished the rally and fail to attend the finish ceremony will be fined \$100 payable to the event organizer.
