




TRACK ENTRANCE



























Tire cleaning with wheel spins before the race is allowed only once BEFORE THE GRID, particular area marked between the lines (see below). It is strongly prohibited to do wheel spins outside the circuit, paddock, pre-grid (except area see below), and grid going to the start position.




























#### 18. AREA WHERE ASSISTANCE IS PERMITTED AFTER RED FLAG

- 18.1. Location see appendix 5.
- 18.2. In a restricted area, there will be an additional zone for repair works. And this zone can be used during the race only when the race has been stopped with a Red Flag and a restart is given immediately.
- 18.3. In this situation, the driver can enter the <u>particular repair</u> area and carry out minor repairs, changing glasses, rechecking the driver's safety equipment and can change tires.
- 18.4. Refueling is allowed only under the following conditions:
  - (a) The engine must be turned off.
  - (b) Fuel cans be carried only in approved plastic or metal fuel canister (max. 20 I, recommended is 10 I) or in an FIA approved fast refueling couplings, max. 50 I barrel (on wheels).
  - (c) Driver must leave the car during refueling, except for persons with movement disorders, however, they must have unfastened seat belts.
  - (d) Mechanics making the refueling must wear long-sleeved clothes and long pants (recommended to use cotton clothes or fire-resistant clothes) and gloves. Or the driver himself make the refueling.
- 18.5. The number of mechanics is limited to 2 persons per car during repair and refueling (the driver is not counted).
- 18.6. If the tires are changed, they must be scanned by scrutineers.
- 18.7. The maximum time for using the additional repair zone is 7 minutes, which is taken from the moment when the last car from that particular start has entered or passed the repair area.
- 18.8. In case of a breach of these instructions (mentioned above), the start will be refused according to Art 11.3.2. of the SportReg.

#### CODE OF DRIVING CONDUCT



#### THE LAW BOOK:

- 1 UNSAFE RETURN TO THE RACING LINE (Art. 14.2.9 of the SportReg)
- 2 CAUSING A COLLISION HARD SIDE BY SIDE OR BACK
- 3 NOT RESPECTING OTHER'S RACING LINES AND CAUSING A COLLISION OR FORCING OFF TRACK
- 4 OPPOSITE DIRECTION STRICTLY FORBIDDEN
  (Art. 12.1.5 of the SportReg)
- ABNORMAL CHANGE OF DIRECTION, CONTACT RESULTING IN A LASTING ADVANTAGE (Art. 2b of the App L of the ISC)
- 6 SERIOUS MISTAKES OR THE APPEARANCE OF A LACK OF CONTROL OVER THE CAR (Art. 2d of the App L of the ISC)
- 7 UNNECESSARILY SLOWLY OR IN A MANNER DEEMED POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS TO OTHER DRIVERS (Art. 2e of the App L of the ISC)

# RED FLAG

# IMMEDIATELY REDUCE SPEED OR STOP AND FOLLOW MARSHAL'S SIGNALS, BE PREPARED TO PROCEED SLOWLY BACK TO START GRID

- Warm-up and free practice no re-run
- Qualifying practice re-run over the total number of laps minus the number of laps completed by the first car
- Qualifying Heats always re-run all laps
- Semi-Final no re-run when the leading car completed four (4) laps
- Final, when no re-run the leading car completed five (5) laps

# ONEYELLOW

# FLAG:

Reduce your speed, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction

- There is a hazard beside or partly on the track
- Overtaking is not permitted between the yellow flag and the incident ...





## DOUBLE YELLOW / REMINDER



REDUCE YOUR SPEED SIGNIFICANTLY, DO NOT OVERTAKE, AND BE PREPARED TO CHANGE DIRECTION OR STOP

- There is a hazard wholly or partly blocking the track and/or "racing line"
- Overtaking is not permitted between the first yellow flag and the incident...

... and has not entirely passed the LAST OBSTACLE

#### BLUE FLAG / REMINDER





#### **During practice:**

A faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.

#### **During the race:**

The flag should normally be shown to a car about to be lapped, if the driver does not seem to be making full use of his rear-view mirrors. When shown, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.

# Don't forget!

- PARK IN THE SAFEST POSSIBLE LOCATION OR DRIVE OUT
- NOT STOPPING ON THE RACING LINE
- OK / INFORM MARSHAL(S)
- GET OUT AT THE SAFEST POSSIBLE TIME
- ONLY BEHIND TRACK BARRIERS
- IF YOU ARE IN A DANGEROUS PLACE LEAVE THE CAR UNTIL INSTRUCTIONS OF MARSHAL
