



SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

KART CROSS Cup 2023

Maggiora 22-24 September

This document contains the particularities of the Competition, partially amending the current version of the Supplementary Regulations of the 2023 FIA European Autocross Championship event, as the KART CROSS Cup is intended to be the support race. For all articles not specified in this document, the Sporting Regulations for Competitions of the FIA European Autocross Championship and the Supplementary Regulations of the FIA event 2023 are valid.

16:15 1st Heat KART CROSS Cup

2nd Heat KART CROSS Cup will be after 1st Heat FIA categories

Sunday, 24 September 2023

10:30 3rd Heat KART CROSS Cup 14:15 Semi-Finals and Finals

Podium on track after the Final

Official Prize Giving ceremony will be near the arena restaurant

II. ORGANISATION

The KART CROSS Cup is a restricted competition with authorised foreign participation. The Organiser accepts the entry of foreign Competitors and/or Drivers with prior authorisation from the ASN which issued their licences, if needed according the regulations. The competition will be run in accordance with the Code (and its Appendices) of the FIA, the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Autocross Championship, General Prescriptions for the Championship and these Regulations (and any other Bulletin which may be issued in writing by the Organiser).

III. GENERAL CONDITIONS

ELIGIBLE CARS

The KART CROSS Cup is open only to Kart Cross max. 600cc., (3 cyl. Yamaha MT-09 850cc / 890cc allowed) in conformity with the current national Technical Regulations and the safety standards (MUDGUARDS MANDATORY). Cars must have a technical passport issued by the ASN. Passports issued by foreign ASNs will be accepted, but weight must be in conformity with the current Italian Technical Regulations for Kart Cross (available online). The maximum number of starters will be 20.

RUNNING OF THE COMPETITION PRACTICE

A warm-up (2 laps) and one timed practice session (4 laps) will be organized.

The starting positions for the timed practice session will be decided by draw.

Each Driver must complete at least one lap in practice. Should this not be the case, the Driver may be allowed to start in the first qualifying Heat, at the discretion of the steward.

The starting grid will always consist of 10 cars (3-2-3-2).

QUALIFYING

There will be 5 laps in the qualifying Heats.

SEMI-FINALS AND FINALS

There will be 6 laps in the Semi-Finals and 7 laps in the Final.

PRIZES AND CUPS

There will be a CUP for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

The podium on track will be immediately after the Final.

The Official Prize Giving ceremony will be organised at the end of the event; Drivers are asked to be present wearing their race overalls.

AUTHORISATION

These Regulations have been agreed by ACI SPORT with no. 06/2023.
