

Lake Superior Performance Rally October 14-15, 2022

BULLETIN #2: LSPR Event and Operations

This bulletin contains information related to:

1. Extended Registration Time

Additional Registration time has been added on Wednesday Oct 12th from 8am to 10am and other times by appointment at the Holiday Inn Copper Iron room. Contact the registrar to make a special appointment.

2. Remote Refuel Revision

The previous information published in the Advance Information under Refuel Information is deleted.

The following information replaces it:

On Saturday, after completion of Stage 10 - Menge Creek, there will be a remote fuel-only stop (no Service allowed) in Covington, MI at the North US 141 Travel Plaza. This is located at the intersection of M-28 and US141. Actual address is: 13352 State Highway M28, Covington, MI 49919.

The entire facility between the blue refuel zone signs is a parc ferme (RCR 4.10.3.c).

Teams may elect to purchase fuel from the Travel Plaza in lieu of using their own fuel at this location. 91 Octane fuel is available. There will also be a refueling zone behind the gas station building (south) on the gravel area for teams that refuel from their own containers.

Competitors are reminded of the following:

- The Refueling rules in RCR 5.8 apply to this location
- Safety precautions per RCR 7.1.9.b will be enforced

Fuel containers:

- Fuel can be dropped off after 10:15am and must be picked up no later than 13:15 (1:15pm)
- All fuel containers must be marked with the competition Car Number
- Catch pans and Fire Extinguishers must be used (Except at the Travel Plaza fuel pumps)
- Lake Superior Performance Rally Staff will be on site to monitor the operations

If the competitor wants/needs to work on the car for anything other than refuel, they must do it prior to entering the refuel zone or after leaving the refuel zone. A penalty will be issued for illegal service if work is done within the refuel zone.

A penalty will also be issued for any work done by a service crew outside of the designated service areas.

3. Service Route for Refuel – to Covington

All service crews and vehicles that are going to the Covington Refuel on Saturday, October 15, will follow this route:

- From the Westwood (east) service area, exit onto Westwood Drive.
- Turn Left and head North to US41/M28 0.2 miles
- Turn Left on US41/M28 and head West 37.8 miles to the blinking light where M28 goes West from US41
- At the next blinker 4.1 miles, the refuel area is on your left. Park in the rear of the facilty on gravel. Be sure to use tarps when refueling. Follow directions of rally officials.

4. Service Route for Refuel - from Covington

When refueling is completed and your rally car has departed, be sure you have cleaned the area you used.

- On the East side of the station, turn left onto US141 and head North to the blinker 0.1 mile
- Turn Right onto M28 and go East 4.1 miles to the blinker
- Turn Right onto US41/M28 and go 37.5 miles East
- Turn Right onto Aspen Ridge School Rd and proceed 0.4 mile South
- Turn Left into the Aspen Ridge School complex. Please observe 15 mph speed limit.
- Service area is ahead for Aspen Ridge and .3 miles for Westwood HS locations.

5. Sanction Exception for SS15 start order

LSPR has requested and received a sanction exception for the modification of the start order at the start of SS15 Mt Marquette until the conclusion of the event. We will be putting the first 10 cars as the last 10 cars to start the stage in reverse order. Competitors 11 through the normal end will start in order with no changes.

6. Change of Event Steward

ARA and LSPR mourn the passing of James Monks who was scheduled to be Event Steward. Justin Pritchard is the replacement ARA Event Steward. Justin's cell phone is 614-348-0394 and his email is justinpritchard550@gmail.com.

7. Clarification of Parc Expose vs Parc Ferme at Marquette Mountain

The last graphic of the Marquette Mountain (ski hill) area distributed with the Advance Information show a Parc Expose in several locations. These areas are actually a Parc Ferme.

8. Availability of Video Recce files (link) – This is unofficial information

A notice of availability was posted to Sportity under the CoC documents.

9. Tire Warmup between ATC and Start

At the 2021 LSPR we received complaints about competitors doing excessive 'tire warmups' between the ATC and Start Line of stages. This is not a safe practice within that area.

Penalty – 120 second penalty per incidence.

Competitors are reminded that control workers are judges of the fact.

10. Scrutineering and Tech Information Change

The previous wording in the Advance Information under Scrutineering / Tech Information is deleted.

The following replaces it:

All teams must request a tech appointment at Scrutineer@LSProRally.com no later than Thursday October 6th. Requests must include the name of presenter and a cell number of presenter along with the time slot requested. Any competitor teams that have not requested a tech time will be assigned a time for tech after October 6th to be posted in a bulletin.
