The Stewards, having received the report from the FIA Technical delegate (doc. No. 4.3 – Annex 10) and after inspecting the situation, summoned and heard the competitor, issued a Decision (doc. No.2.15), determined the following :

Driver and car No: Michal ŠPILKA, 158

Competitor: AMK Ecce Homo Šternberk v ÚAMK

Time (fact): 17:15 hrs

Session: After 3rd Practice heat

Fact: During the scrutineering after 3rd Practice heat, the rear axle width measure results were out of the tolerance. The rear axle width declared by the competitor in the PF technical sheet (FIA-PF-ID.Y5C1.963.643) is 1710 mm. The tolerance is +/- 20 mm. The measured axle width at the rear is: 1660 mm (50 mm less than the declared one).




By recalculating the Performance factor number results, does not change the classification group

Offence: Breach of art.258-1-16.7.10 of the Appendix J.

Decision: A fine of 250€ which is suspended until the end of the 2024 season, subject to do not further breach of a non-conformity with the PF technical data (outside of tolerance but without changing of group), observed during scrutineering under PF regulations (at any time after the publication of the first "starting order list"), is imposed in accordance with Article 21.1.14 EHC Sporting Regulations – Category 1. It is first time infringement during the season.

Reason: Having considered the matter extensively, the Stewards determined that measurement has been carried out complying with the regulations and at no time during the Competition may the car measurements be out of tolerance reported in the PF Technical sheet entered in the Competition and comply with the tolerance established by the technical regulations.

The Competitor is reminded of his right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
