

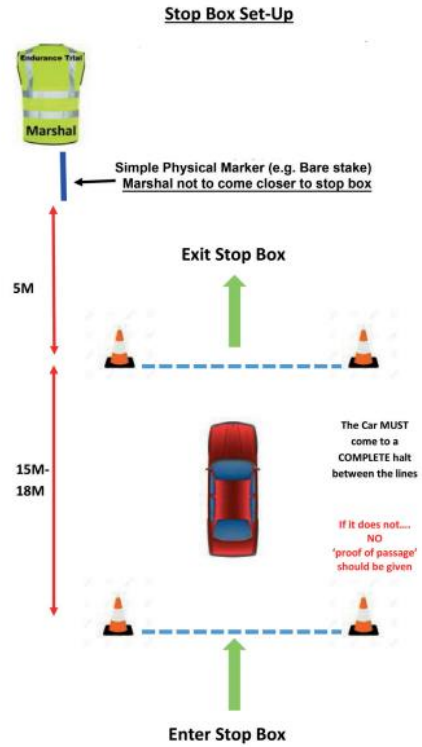
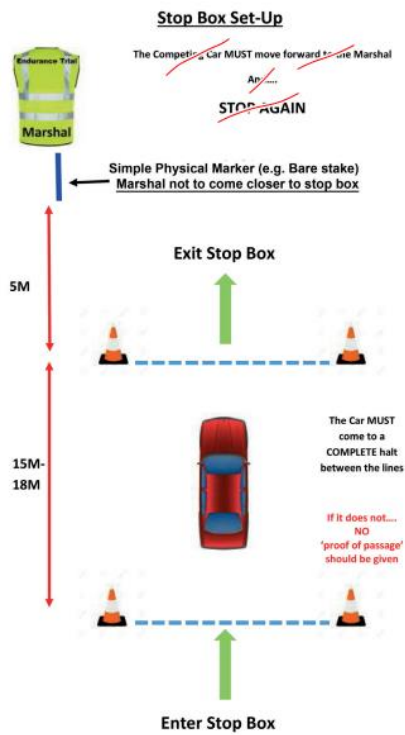
## Form for Proposal for Rule Change

1. Proposals for Rule Changes must be submitted by the relevant Commission to the Rules Commission by email ([RulesCommission@gmail.com](mailto:RulesCommission@gmail.com)) in 'Word' (.doc or .docx) form.
2. Deleted text must be entered in the "Existing Rule" box with strikethroughs as appropriate i.e. ~~deleted text~~.
3. New text must be entered in the "Proposed Rule" box in bold lettering and underlined i.e. **new text**.
4. New rules or rule changes become effective when approved by Rules Commission, confirmed by the Motorsport Council and published in accordance with GCR 180.

| <p><b>Detail Reasons for Proposed Rule Change:</b><br/>         Following the reporting of numerous instances of congestion at STOP BOXES during the year, the Navigation Trial Sub Commission wish to now propose a rule change to alleviate the congestion and to improve the safety of the Marshal positioned 5 m after the STOP BOX</p> <p>The Marshal will use a STOP Sign paddle, to direct the competitor to STOP and only when the Marshal has adjudged the competitor as having come to a complete halt will they raise the paddle to signify that the competitors is free to proceed.</p> <p>The introduction of the STOP SIGN Paddle will improve the safety of the marshal, by removing the requirement to stop a second time. The Stop Box Set up Diagram is updated accordingly</p> |  |
| <b>The effective date will be as per note 4 above, unless a <u>later date is stated here:</u></b>   |  |
| <p><b>Existing Rule:</b></p> <p><del>1. The competitor has to stop to collect a marshal's signature or demonstrate other proof of passage as directed by the organisers, such as collecting a unique token specific to the event or selective. Note: playing cards must not be used.</del></p>  | <p><b>Proposed Rule:</b></p> <p>1. The Marshal will display a STOP sign paddle as the competitor approaches the STOP BOX. Once the Competitor has come to a complete stop, the STOP Sign paddle will be lifted, and the competitor will then be free to proceed.</p> |
