1. Under no circumstances are competitors allowed to use cameras or on-board recording equipment on any of the tests as they are held on private land.

2. Trailer parking is available at rally HQ (see Overview Map on Sportity)

3. Please drive with care on Road Sections and particularly on Narrow Roads and on the Approach/Exit of Selectives. As per Appendix 35.17 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook, driving in a manner which would bring the Motor Club and Motorsport into disrepute will result in exclusion. Penalties may be applied as per Appendix 35.19 of the current Yearbook.

6. All signed-on marshals and officials are Judges of Fact, for time-keeping and monitoring driving behaviour.

7. Please be aware of and familiarize yourself with Appendix 35 of the 2024 Motorsport Ireland Yearbook particularly in relation to Stop Box Layout and Procedures for Crews and Marshalls.
8. The onus is on competitors to ensure that you have entered the correct class.
9. We would ask that all competitors to please respect the land owners.
10. There is NO PETROL available at the H.Q.
11. Car numbers must be placed on the rear side windows and not on the doors.
12. Competition Licences for both driver and navigator must be produced at Sign On. Also all drivers must be IRDS database as published on www.motorsportireland.com
13. Navigators may get their Roadbook & Selective Diagrams at Documentation Scrutiny without needing the Driver to be present. Timecards & Car Numbers will be withheld until both crew members have all Paper & Mechanical Scrutiny Complete.
14. **MARSHALS ARE NEEDED!** Please contact Darren Delaney on 085-8437131 if you can assist. All help appreciated.
15. Competitors are reminded to refer to the 2024 Yearbook/Sportity Updates with regards to correct usage of tyres. NO GRAVEL/FORESTRY TYRES ALLOWED.
16. A Measured Kilometre will be located on the Birr side of HQ and will be marked using arrows. Turn right on main road at HQ and measured KM will be arrowed.
17. CCTV & Marshals will be deployed on a Number of Codeboards to ensure that Crews are not using any form of recording devices in the form of Camera Phones, Dictaphones, Phones or any other form of Data Recording Device. Penalty of Exclusion will apply to any crew using such recording devices.
