4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The rally will be organised in accordance with the current **AKK regulations**, the **Finnish Rally Championship (Ralli SM) Regulations**, and these Supplementary Regulations of the **SM Porvoon Autopalvelu Rally**, approved by AKK Motorsport under permit number **18938/RA/26**. In the event of any discrepancy, the Finnish version of the Supplementart Regulations shall prevail.

The total length of the rally is **256.33 km**, including **10 special stages** with a total distance of **80.28 km**, of which approximately **2 km** are on tarmac. Round hay bales will be used as cutting-prevention barriers on special stages.

If a competitor, or any person acting on behalf of the competitor, is found on the route in the municipalities of **Porvoo, Askola, Pornainen, Pukkila or Mäntsälä** on roads marked yellow, grey, black, or not marked at all on the official Finnish road map before the competitor's start time, with the exception of the official reconnaissance period specified in Section 1 "Programme" for Classes 1-17, the competitor will be refused permission to start the rally.

The event will follow the regulations of the **Finnish Center for Integrity in Sports (SUEK)**, available at suek.fi, as well as all applicable anti-doping legislation.

6. ENTRIES

All competitors wishing to participate in the **SM Porvoon Autopalvelu Rally** must submit their entry through the **KITI system** by **14 September 2026 at 20:00**, or request alternative entry instructions from the Secretary of the Rally.

The electronic administrative checks and required forms are available via **Sportity**.

A maximum of **190 competitors** complying with the regulations will be accepted. If the maximum number of entries is exceeded, competitors may be selected according to the following criteria:

- Selection will be made from Classes 18-31.
- Date and time of receipt of the entry fee by the organiser.
- Competitor's rally history and results.

Competitor Data Processing by the Organiser

By submitting an entry to the competition, the competitor consents to the processing of their personal data by the organiser and to the publication of specified personal details (such as name, club, etc.) in the entry list, results, and other competition-related communications.

The first driver's licence number must be used as the payment reference.

8. SERVICE

A **flexi-service** will be used during regrouping halts. There are two (2) service halts on the route, between **SS 4 and SS 5** and between **SS 7 and SS 8**.

Upon arrival at the TC Service In, competitors will be given both a **Service In** and a **Service Out** time. The allotted time includes:

- a 3-minute technical inspection period,
- the regrouping period, and
- a 30-minute service period.

Competitors may start their 30-minute service period at a time of their choosing within the allotted time.

The competitor must record the service start and finish times on the designated page of the road book. This page must be displayed under the windshield of the competition car during servicing so that it is visible to officials.

No service work may be performed on the car after the 30-minute service period has ended.

Each crew is responsible for ensuring that the service start time is clearly visible in the vehicle window.

Violations related to service time, including:

- starting service too early, or
- exceeding the permitted service time,

will be penalised in accordance with Article 15.8 of the 2026 Finnish Rally Championship Regulations.

The service area is located near the rally headquarters at: **Kokonniementie 3, FI-06100 Porvoo**

Servicing is permitted only within the area designated by the organiser.

Each service vehicle must carry:

- a competitor-specific fire extinguisher,
- an oil-absorbent mat ready for use, and
- a liquid-proof groundsheet underneath the rally car, at least equal in size to the vehicle footprint.

Failure to provide any of the above will result in immediate exclusion from the competition by decision of the Clerk of the Course.

A protective groundsheet of at least engine-bay size must also be placed under the service vehicle. Failure to comply will result in a **€100 penalty** imposed by the Clerk of the Course.

The organiser may charge an **€80 cleaning fee** if a service area is left uncleaned.

9. TYRES

The maximum number of tyres permitted for Classes 1-6 is six (6).

Tyre marking and inspections will be carried out in accordance with the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations.

The use of tyres will be monitored throughout the event.

No tyre code form is required in advance.

10. REFUELLING

Competitors may refuel with **95E or 98E fuel** at the **ST1 Kuninkaanportti service station**, marked in the road book.

Refuelling is permitted only from the station fuel pumps.

Competitors using:

- FIA fuel,
- E85 fuel, or
- two-stroke vehicles

may refuel from their own fuel containers with the assistance of a helper at the designated refuelling area near the service park, as indicated in the road book.

Refuelling anywhere else along the route is prohibited.

Any breach of the refuelling regulations will result in immediate exclusion from the competition by decision of the Clerk of the Course.

11. RECONNAISSANCE

From **07:00 on 25 September 2026**, competitors may collect reconnaissance materials from the Rally Office.

All electronic forms must be completed by **23 September 2026 at 23:59**.

GPS tracking units will be distributed together with the reconnaissance materials and must be used throughout the reconnaissance period.

Competitors must provide a USB power source in the reconnaissance vehicle and keep the GPS device connected for the entire duration of reconnaissance.

After reconnaissance, and before the competitor's start time, the GPS tracking device must be transferred to the rally car.

Two (2) reconnaissance vehicle identification stickers supplied by the organiser must be affixed:

- at the top centre of the windshield, and
- on the right rear side window.

These identifiers must remain clearly visible throughout the reconnaissance period.

Competitors must comply with Finnish road traffic legislation and all subordinate regulations during both reconnaissance and the rally. During reconnaissance, a speed limit of **80 km/h** applies on all special stages unless a lower limit is imposed by road signs or by signs installed by the organiser. Driving must be conducted in a manner that does not endanger or disturb other road users or nearby residents. Driving against the direction of a special stage is strictly prohibited.

The organiser will monitor both speed and driving behaviour during reconnaissance. The police will also monitor the route and enforce traffic offences in accordance with Finnish traffic legislation. Competitors must obey any stop signal given by officials carrying organiser identification. Failure to comply may result in refusal of permission to start.

Reconnaissance of the route is permitted subject to the following restriction:

12. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

The competition number panels used in the rally will measure **67 cm × 20 cm**.

Scrutineering for Classes 1-17 will begin on **Friday, 25 September 2026 at 15:00**, according to the appointment schedule.

Scrutineering for Classes 18-31 will begin on **Saturday, 26 September 2026 at 08:00**. Competitor materials for these classes will be distributed at the same time.

The documents required for scrutineering, in accordance with Article 11.1 of the Finnish Rally Championship Regulations, must be submitted by e-mail no later than **22 September 2026 at 15:00** to:

The e-mail subject line must contain the competition number and the driver's name.

If a competitor wishes to change their scrutineering time after the booking system has closed, the organiser will charge a fee of **€50**. The same fee will be charged to competitors who fail to reserve a time and whose scrutineering appointment is assigned by the organiser. The fee must be paid at the Competition Office no later than one hour before the competitor's start time.

The competition car must be presented at scrutineering approximately **10 minutes before** the appointed scrutineering time. At the same time, officials will verify that the cars are in the correct order and present at the correct time.

Sealing

- Spare parts that must be registered and sealed for the competition will be inspected and, if necessary, sealed during scrutineering. More detailed instructions will be provided in the Competitor Guide.
- Replacement of a sealed component during the rally is permitted only with the approval of the Chief Scrutineer.

Scrutineering will close **10 minutes after the end of the inspection time of the last competition number**.

14. SHAKEDOWN STAGE

There will be **no shakedown stage** in the event.

Both crew members must attend the material distribution and present either a driving licence or other valid identification.

Materials Distributed

Each crew will receive:

- Road Book containing the detailed route of the rally
- Two (2) route maps
- GPS tracking device
- Reconnaissance vehicle identification stickers
- All competition number stickers
- Championship windshield sticker (if required)

The timing transponder will be distributed at the start area before the competitor's start time.

The international time card will be issued at the rally start.

16. START

The list of competitors authorised to start will be published according to the programme in the Sportity application.

Competitors will receive their FIA-style international time card at the start. An international time card system will be used.

The rally start will take place at **10:01 at Taidetehdas (Art Factory)**, Läntinen Aleksanterinkatu 1, FI-06100 Porvoo

The competition will use official Finnish time, available at: <https://time.is>

Competitors must follow the route prescribed by the organiser throughout the rally. Failure to follow the designated route may result in a penalty imposed by the Clerk of the Course, depending on the severity of the infringement (Rally Sporting Regulations, Article 20.6).

17. REGROUPING

The rally includes two (2) regrouping halts, as indicated in the rally timetable.
