







IMPORTANT REMINDER

In this example it is **ALLOWED** to start NT 2.2 too early




































IMPORTANT REMINDER

DESCRIPTION

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- A very nice complete stage, containing everything a desert lover would like to have on the menu for his day.
- Beginning of the stage on gravel tracks, then sandy in large valleys.
- A small Dune Test as a warm-up will give you some height, before descending towards your first Navigation Test.
 Respect your CAPs and make attention to all roadbook details during this NT.
- Vigilance during transfer zone when you will walk along an old railway line, tracks are sometimes damaged.
- You will end with grandiose landscapes, one of the highest Dune Tests of the rally, and a very nice smooth NT.

































DETAILS:

- From KP 323 to 345: Stony tracks, some holes and steps on the way up, be careful!
- From KP 345 to 357: Sandy and off-road tracks, sometimes with sharp bumps. Remember to set your tyre pressure!
- From KP 355 to 356: First short Dune Test of the day. Very load-bearing sand. It will give you a great view of the next NT.
- !!! Very important at KP 380.51: Crossing with the Dakar at CP 1 Respect the speed limit zone and give way to the Dakar.
- From KP 384 to 408: Bad tracks along an old railway, many holes and cuts Danger!! and!!! Be very careful on this section, the time limit has been calculated so that you do not take any risks.
- From KP 412 to 441: Alternating visible and sometimes not very visible tracks, becoming sandy as you approach
- PK 426,13 > SLOW, camp. Average speed = 30 km/h for each Average Speed Group (no PCI during minimum 1 km after PK 426,13)
- CP 2.KP 441 : CP 2 Crossing of a busy road, be careful when crossing it and respect the DZ/FZ.
- From PK 443 to 486: Keep your eyes open, this will be one of the most beautiful RTs of the rally, fast white sand tracks in the middle of great scenery
- From KP 492 to 495: If you want to gain altitude again, then go through the 2nd Dune Test of the day. These dune mountains will be just as tricky as the last descent. Watch out for the Danger!! at KP 494 a big descent at over 25%.
- From KP 500 to 539: A last very smooth NT on nice sandy tracks will lead you to the Alula bivouac.

FUEL: Refueling at Bivouac.

Petrol-stations: On liaison A: KM 119 – 120 – 150 – 167 - 184 & KM 235 (LAST PETROL STATION BEFORE TC2)

!!! Don't wait for last petrol station to refuel

On liaison B: None (Direct arrival at the bivouac).
