RSAC SCOTTISH RALLY: 18 JULY 2026

I refer to your correspondence dated 23 June 2026 relative to the above event. I write to acknowledge the route of the event on the public road network for the competitors and I have no issues with same.

I note the start and finish will be at the Jas P Wilson's yard Dalbeattie and competitors can be expected to start arriving on the afternoon/evening of Friday 17th July.

At stages where spectator access is permitted, I suggest measures are taken to provide spectator car parking facilities off the public road. Furthermore, the location of any control points on the route should not obstruct the passage of other road users.

Given parts of the rally routes travels through residential area I suggest competitors be reminded to drive according to the conditions and keep noise levels to a minimum.

I have highlighted the route to AMEY, for the Trunk Roads and Dumfries and Galloway Council, for the local road network. I haven't been notified of any planned works that are likely to hinder the rally route.

In addition, as in previous years there is a parade planned in Castle Douglas. This will start at 1pm and be finished by 2pm.

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Finally, I have notified Officers of the proposed route and subject to other duties checks will be carried out. I wish your organisation a successful event.
