The Stewards, have received a report from the Clerk of the Course, summoned and heard the Co-Driver Mr. Cameron FAIR, studied GPS data, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Fact:** The Competitor Car No 22 did not follow the road book from the page 1-65 position 21 till the page 1- 66 position 26

**Offence:** Art. 19.2 of FIA RRSR 2023

**Decision:** Reprimand

**Reason:** Clerk of the Course reported that Car No 22 did not follow the road book from page 1-65 position 21 till page 1-66 position 26.

Mr. Cameron FAIR (Co-Driver) explained the case that he had to do some simultaneous job during their passing on liaison and at some point they got lost. After the Crew members realized that they have lost and they were looking for Refuel Area they made U-turn and moved back to rejoin the route not respecting a road book.

The Stewards concluded breach of the regulations, but due to the fact that the crew got lost, always moved, did not stop, decided, that imposing of Reprimand will be appropriate in current case.

The decision is based on the FIA International Sporting Code Art. 11.9.1, Art.11.9.2.a, Art. 11.9.3.a, Art. 11.9.3.f, 11.9.3.x, 12.4.1.b.

Competitors are reminded of their right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter 4 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.
