Driving Standards

You are reminded to drive with courtesy to all road users on the public highway. Some road sections of the event consist of narrow single track lanes please drive with due care and consideration.

Respect **ALL** quiet zones and slow in the road book and any additional signage placed on the road sections.

- **Abbey – Cwm -Hir.** Road book page 20 box 11 & page 53 box 16 **VERY QUIET and VERY SLOW** for 1.75 miles to TC 1/5.

No tyre or brake warming whatsoever.

Driving Standards observers **WILL** be in attendance.

- **Liaison section SF2/6 to TC3/7.** Road book pages 33 / 34 and 67 / 68
- This is a private road. Access has been granted by Cefn Croes wind farm, on the basis that a speed limit of 20mph maximum **must be adhered to.**

The road is being used by engineers from the wind farm on the day of the event.

The time allowance is extremely generous. **No** Tyre or brake warming.

Any standards of driving likely to bring the sport into disrepute will not be tolerated.

Driving standards observers will be in attendance.

Tracking will be monitored

The ability to use this section of road on future events rests with your compliance.

- Road book pages 45 & 77 box 1 to 4. **VERY QUIET and VERY SLOW. Narrow two-way Road.**

Driving Standards observers **WILL** be in attendance

SS1/5 Sarnau

Total 1.97 miles. Inside of road on left is falling away. Anti cut put in place. Don't cut.



SS3/7 Road conditions

Junction 12 to 13. Between these two junctions the road surface has been repaired with large stone. The surface is uncompacted and likely to become rough.

SS3/7 Logging information

From stage miles 8.63 to 9.22 log piles are present on both sides of the road. There are additional piles through this section added since the route notes survey was carried out.

All can be seen on approach. Stay neat.
