

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS NO.1

- Thank you for your entry. Your Competition Number is detailed on the club website www.omaghmotorclub.co.uk, on the club's Facebook page, and on the Sportity App. (password FIVETOWN24). Competitors should ensure that they are entered in the correct class on the entry list. Failure to do this may result in you being excluded from the results at the end of the event.
- 2. Please ensure that both crew members sign-on on www.rallyscore.net
- 3. Scrutiny is in the Service Park at Campbell Contracts, Coolcran, Tempo, BT94 3FR (GPS 54.24096 N / 7.27546 / What 3 Words catch.paths.unclaimed) between 7.00pm and 9.00pm on Friday 23rd February. A noise test will be carried out at the scrutiny venue. Noise testing may also be carried out during the event.

Cars 1-20 should report between 7.00pm and 7.30pm.

Cars 21-40 should report between 7.30pm and 8.00pm

Cars 41-60 should report between 8.00pm and 8.30pm

- 4. At Scrutiny cars will be examined for compliance with, noise, tyre and vehicle regulations as well as class eligibility, and spot checks will be carried out throughout the event. All competitors are reminded that they must be able to produce; a Vehicle Registration document, a Motorsport UK/MI Vehicle Passport / Log Book, and a current MOT/NCT certificate where applicable. Vehicles registered outside the UK are subject to the MOT regulations that apply in their country of origin. Paper copies of MOT certificates and Car Tax must be available for inspection by the Scrutineers. Electronic copies of these documents produced on a phone or other electronic device are not acceptable. Helmets, Clothing and Frontal Head Restraints must be produced for inspection.
- 5. The Service Park is at Campbell Contracts, Coolcran, Tempo. The Service Park is open from 6.00pm to 9.30pm on Friday evening and from 6.30am on Saturday morning. All vehicles must be in place by 8.00am on Saturday morning. Only one Service vehicle will be admitted to the Service Park. Please obey the instructions of the marshals. All crews must use ground sheets and keep their location tidy and clear of rubbish at all times. Servicing is only permitted in the Service Park. The Service Park gates will be closed on Friday night and Service Vehicles and Rally cars may be left overnight at the venue.
- 6. Smoking is not permitted in the Service Park. Ideally re-fuelling should be by hand pumping, rather than from handheld containers. If fuel is dispensed from handheld containers a suitable spout for pouring must be used. Open pouring from handheld containers with or without the use of a funnel is not permitted. The vehicle must be unoccupied e.g., driver, navigator, service crew, when re-fuelling commences, and the engine switched off. Re-fuelling personnel must wear clothing that provides adequate

- protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top and closed shoes. It would be good practice to also wear gloves and a balaclava.
- 7. A **Trailer Park will be available** 1.9 miles from the Service Park at Tempo Maguires GAC,Tempo, BT94 3HU (GPS 54.38058 N, 7.45813 W / What 3 Words mincing.appraised.bloodshot) on Friday night and Saturday. The Trailer Park will close at 7.00pm on Saturday.
- 8. The Rally Office is located at Campbell Contracts and will be open from 7pm to 9.30pm on Friday evening and from 7am on Saturday morning A Roadbook, Timecards and an Entry List will be supplied by the organisers in sealed folders and can be collected from Rally Office in the Service Park. Competition numbers can also be collected from Rally Office. Please ensure that you enter your competition number on each of the Timecards when you open this pack. Please ensure that you clearly fill in the relevant Arrival times, Stage Start times and Stage Finish times and show your timecard to an official before leaving any control.
- Competitors will be required to complete a Tyre Declaration form which will be in the Roadbook. This must be completed prior to the Start Control and any tyre changes in Service must be added before the Service Out control. Spare tyres must also be listed on the form.
- 10. Competitors are reminded that they must have their competition licences and membership cards available for inspection upon request. No licence application will be permitted on the day. Any non-production of a licence must be accompanied by an email from Motorsport UK or MSI and will be referred to the Motorsport UK Steward of the event.
- 11. A Competitor's Briefing will take place at 8.30am outside Rally HQ in the Service Park. Attendance by all drivers and co-drivers is mandatory.
- 12. Competitors should make themselves aware of what actions to take if they are the first on scene of an incident. Please watch the "First on Scene" video on the following weblink; https://www.omaghmotorclub.co.uk/competitors/
- 13. Pre-event documentation and any instructions issued during the event will be available on the Sportity App which can be downloaded free of charge. The password for the event is FIVETOWN24.
- 14. The Supplementary Regulations for the event are amended as follows;

- 15. Start Times will be displayed at the Start Control and on the Sportity App.
- 16. Please ensure that you are familiar with the **SOS/OK procedure** which is detailed in the front of the Roadbook.

- 17. **If you retire from the event**, please have your timecards ready for collection by the Tailsweep car. Delaying the Tailsweep car while you look for your timecards can cause a delay in the rally time schedule.
- 18. Competitors who retire from the event on Special Stages 1-5 will have the opportunity to have further competition providing they confirm their intention to the Competitor Liaison Officer thirty minutes prior to the first car due time of the subsequent section (Service Out Control prior to Special Stage 6). Vehicles MUST be rescrutineered and this scrutineering will take place in the event Service Park. Timecards will be issued by the Competitor Relations Officer upon completion of re-scrutiny. Competitors will be re-seeded at the Clerk of the Course's discretion.
- 19. Food will be available from on-site catering.
- 20. The PSNI have been informed of the route so please ensure that you comply with all road traffic regulations.
- 21. All Senior Officials named in these regulations and the following are deemed to be Judges of Fact in respect of illegal servicing and driving standards; Pete Curran, Ryan McKenna, Mark Thompson, Kevin Lynam, Larry Harpur, Gerry McConnell, Caroline McGuinness, Conrad Walls, William Wylie and Eddie Rafferty.
- 22. If you become aware that you will be unable to compete in the event can you please advise the event secretary of your intention to withdraw ASAP.
- 23. Reseed requests will only be accepted up to midday on Friday 23rd February. A reseed request form should be completed and submitted via e-mail to the CRO (gary.milligan@btinternet.com) or event secretary (barrymoneill76@gmail.com).
- 24. In an effort to revive the social side of the event in there will be driver interviews at a ceremonial start and mid-morning regroup in Fivemiletown High School. A prizegiving will be held immediately after the event in Downeys Jubilee Bar, 122, Main Street, Fivemiletown. The bar is owned by Nigel Downey who will be carrying out the above interviews so please support this function and let's try to revive some of the spirit of former Fivemiletown rallies.
