Information about the 100 m race

All skaters are automatically registered for all races in their age group except for the 100 m road race:

Due to logistical issues and the closure of the main avenue in the city of Lagos – Avenida dos Descobrimentos – participation in this race is subject to certain restrictions.

For the **100 metres road race**, all skaters in the **Junior and Senior** age groups (i.e. the **Absolutos** category) who are interested in taking part must register for this race when collecting their bib numbers, indicating their interest on a separate form available in the tournament office.

On this form, they must specify their best ever international result in the 100 m race (World Championships, European Championships, Pan American Championships, Asian Games, etc.).

In the **Absolutos** (Juniors and Seniors) age group, the race will not count towards the tournament ranking and will have its own specific prize money.

30 skaters (20 Seniors and 10 Juniors) will be selected from those who have registered for the race, based primarily on their international ranking and secondly on their classification/time in the 500 metres race. If any of the skaters selected for the race are unable to compete, they must inform the organization committee so that they can be substituted by the next skater in the ranking.

In the **Cadetes and Youth** age groups, the top 18 skaters in the ranking by the end of the second day's races will participate in the 100 m race, which counts towards the individual final ranking of the tournament. If any of the skaters who qualify for the race are unable to compete, they must inform the organization committee so that they can be substituted by the next skater in the ranking.
