Dispensation Review — Jordan Poole (GMJ Racing) & Nicholas Round (Randy Racing)

At the commencement of the 2026 season, No Limits Racing received dispensation requests for Jordan Poole (GMJ Racing) and Nicholas Round (Randy Racing) to compete within the Team Sport Trophy Endurance class. Following a review of the supporting evidence submitted at that time, both dispensations were granted, permitting the riders to compete as part of teams entered into either the Team Sport Trophy or Team Power Trophy classes.

Following feedback received from a number of teams and a thorough analysis of data gathered across the first three rounds of the 2026 season, No Limits Racing has made the decision to revoke the dispensations previously granted to both Jordan Poole and Nicholas Round.

This decision has not been taken lightly. No Limits Racing is committed to ensuring fair and balanced competition across all classes, and it is in the interest of the championship as a whole that all competitors are placed in the most appropriate class for their level.

What Happens Next

With immediate effect, both GMJ Racing and Randy Racing will be transferred to the National 600 class.

All results recorded by both teams at Rounds 1, 2 and 3 of the 2026 season will be amended to reflect their reclassification into the National 600 class. Championship standings for all affected classes will be updated accordingly.

Updated championship standings will be published on the No Limits Racing website and communicated through official channels in due course.
