





Driving in Paraguay.

17.1 Motorway Tolls

- Tolls in Paraguay must be paid in cash only.
- Carry at least Gs 100,000 daily.
- Rental cars do not include toll devices.

17.2 Traffic Rules

- Drive on the **right** and overtake on the **left**.
- Seat belts are mandatory for both the driver and all passengers.
- Hand-held mobile phone use while driving is prohibited.
- Blood/alcohol limit is 0 mg. Random alcohol tests may be conducted by police.
- Carry 2 red reflective triangles to place in visible positions if the vehicle stops, as well as a fire extinguisher.
- Car lights must be on at all times while driving.

17.3 Speed Limits

• Urban areas: 50 km/h

• Main roads: 110 km/h

• The **driver** is fully responsible for any traffic violations.















Recommended Sanitary Protocol.

The organization considers the protection of all attendees' health a fundamental pillar. Given that Paraguay has a subtropical climate, and is endemic—and in some cases hyperendemic—to various vector-borne diseases, prevention plays a strategic role in safeguarding public health.

The implementation of this plan is carried out in close coordination with institutions under the Ministry of Public Health and Social Welfare (MSPyBS), such as the National Service for Malaria Eradication (SENEPA) and the General Directorate of Health Surveillance (DGVS). This ensures a comprehensive, inter-institutional approach to the prevention and control of vector-borne diseases in the most sensitive areas of the host cities.

This protocol will be applied in sports facilities, accommodation areas, public zones, service areas, and any other critical spaces related to the development of the events.

Surface: Walls, baseboards, cracks, textiles and other areas where insects can take refuge.

INESFLY LARVA IGR

Use: Larvae control.

Places: Fountains, puddles, gutters and other deposits of stagnant water.

Surface: Any place that can hold water.
