# 2. SEEDING

A seeded entry list <u>https://www.rallies.info/webentry/2025/manx/entries.php?type=s</u> seeding has been done using the information provided along with other sources of event results.

Whist we have endeavoured to make the seeding as fair and accurate as possible we accept that oversights can happen. If you believe that your seeding presents a genuine safety issue, please email <u>chris.woodcock99@gmail.com</u> stating; why you believe your seeding is incorrect, where you think you should be moved to and what supporting evidence you have to substantiate your request.

Competitors are reminded that following Leg 1 and Leg 2 cars will be re-seeded, and the restart order will be based on the overall classification from the previous Leg.

# 3. SERVICE

Each competitor will be issued with one service vehicle sticker which must be affixed to the relevant service vehicle. Only vehicles with either a competitor sticker or Service sticker will be permitted within the Service Area. All other vehicles must be parked in the event car park as shown on the diagram below. No trailers will be permitted within the Service Area (unless these are to be used as an alternative to service vehicle) Please unload in the trailer park, not the Service Area as this will be tight there. Please be considerate to others and to the surroundings there is to be no vehicles driving on the grass. Competitors will be allocated specific spaces within the Service Area. If multiple competitors wish to service close to each other please send an email titled "Service Allocation" to manx@pdextinguishers.co.uk or call 07425879024 (no later than 9pm please if phoning) In this please include your competitor number and drivers name for yourself and who you wish to be allocated a space with no later than 12 Noon on Thursday 3rd April. The Service Area will be restricted on opening times so the service park manager is not out all hour these will be as follows:

Unfortunately, overnight camping is not permitted within the Service Area or wider TT Grandstand Area. This area is private property and any competitor's found to be staying on either site overnight will be prosecuted. This includes the use of tents, motorhomes or campervans.

## 4. Documentation

Please ensure you have you process card MSUK licence and Club Cards in hand at documentation. You will be unable to sign on without these and we do require both driver and codriver to attend sign on. This can be done separately but your process card won't be taken until you have both signed on and displayed documentation. If you have any highlighted sections on the process card, please complete these before displaying or you will be refused sign on until you have taken this away and completed.

## 5. RECONNAISSANCE

Competitors can choose one of the following sessions to recce (location of sign on) :

Sunday 5 April 2025	07:00hrs – 20.00hrs (Conference centre)
Thursday 10 April 2025	07:00hrs – 20.00hrs (Race office)

You will be required to use the Tracky App during Recce Details of this are on Sportity Please ensure you have the app downloaded when you arrive at Recce signing on. Competitors will be permitted to take part in one recce session only. During the recce session competitors must only traverse the stages during the times detailed above.

No more than two passes of each stage will be permitted. During the recce competitors must complete their Recce Record Card which will detail the time they enter and exit each stage. This doesn't need to be handed in but please keep it on you in case you are asked for it. Throughout recce there will be event Officials located at different points on the stages and upon request competitors must present their Recce Record Card to the Event Official for inspection. Prior to commencing the recce competitors must attend Reconnaissance documentation at the Race Office, TT Grandstand, Douglas, where they can collect the Recce Record Card and Recce car numbers and Road book.

Any competitors found to be breaching any of the regulations detailed in this bulletin or the Supplementary Regulations in relation to reconnaissance will be penalised as per Paragraph 9 of the Supplementary Regulations:

- First Offence £250 fine / and or refused start
- Second Offence Refused start

## 6. SCRUTINEERING

Noise Test will take place within the Service Area as shown on the diagram in Appendix A. Competitors must have all event decals in place before proceeding to Noise Test. These can be collected from the Race Office. Upon completion of the Noise Test competitors should proceed to Scrutineering at the Scrutineering Bays within the TT Grandstand. Noise Test and Scrutineering will take place between the following times:

Thursday 10 <sup>th</sup> April	16:00 – 19:45hrs
Friday 11 <sup>th</sup> April	08:00 – 09:15hrs

During Thursday daytime the scrutineers will be around the service area and will be happy to scrutineer any cars with their service crews that are ready prior to the official start at 16:00hrs.

#### 7. Shakedown

A shakedown stage will take place on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April starting at 09:30hrs. The shakedown stage is 2.79 miles. Competitors wishing to partake in the shakedown must be in position at the Service Out control as per a start list that will be published no later than 08:00hrs on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April. Any competitor that is not ready to leave at the stated time may forfeit their run.

Competitors will start the shakedown stage in seeded order at approximately 30 second intervals. There will be no official timing for this stage.

There is no additional charge for partaking in the shakedown.

Competitors will be permitted one pass of the shakedown stage only.

# 8. VEHICLE TRACKING

All competing cars will be fitted with a tracking device provided by Sporttraxx. The tracking device will be installed by a Sport Traxx official prior to the Shakedown and removed at MTC7. Competitors not partaking in the Shakedown will have their tracker fitted prior to MTC1. All competitors should familiarise themselves with the operating instructions prior to starting the rally (these can be found of Sportity) Under no circumstances should the tracking device be turned off. If you retire from the event the tracking device must be returned to Rally HQ. Any competitor that does not return their tracking device may be reported to Motorsport UK.

# 9. INSURANCE

All competitors wishing to use the REIS insurance for Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the event must read and be able to confirm to the requirements of the policy. Please mark whether you would like to use the insurance on your entry form.

# **10. COMPETITOR BRIEFING /TIMECARDS**

The compulsory competitor briefing will be held on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> April at 8am The event will be using contactless timing. Timecards will be issued for competitors own records. These will be distributed at the Competitor Briefing. A location will be advised at signing on and on Sportity.
