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1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. This rally will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) incluinding appendices, the FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations incluinding appendices and the ASN Technical Regulations (only when related to national cars) the WADA/NADA Codes, and FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins.

4. ENTRIES

4.1. Closing date for entries

Friday, 30th June at 17:00 hours with a reduced fee Monday, 17th July at 17:00 hours

4.2. Entry procedure

All applications will be submitted and managed online. User LOGIN required http://www.ralivm.com

Each applicant will have a specific user ID to log in and fill out the form.

All indicated required fields must be filled out before the closing date for entries.

The application will only be accepted if the following documents in PDF format are attached **by July 17**, 2023:

- Driver and co-driver identification (identification card or passport)
- Entrant, driver and co-driver competition licenses
- Driver and co-driver driving Licences
- ASN authorisation, for all foreign competitors
- Car documentation (logbook and ownership document)
- In the case where the competition vehicle ownership is not registered to either of the drivers, a notarized document from the owner is required, authorising the vehicle to participate in Rali Vinho da Madeira 2023.
- Homologation page for the entered car on which the number, the group, and cylinder capacity (cc) are indicated
- FIA Technical passport

The entry will only be accepted after confirmation of payment within the deadlines stipulated in Art. 4.1. An entry application (also made electronically) will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fee.

According to the Internacional Sporting Code, Art 3.8.1 an entry compels the competitor to take part in the Competition in which they have been accepted to run, except in the case of duly established Force Majeure.

4.6. Entry fee refunds

Entry fees will be refunded in full:

- a) To candidates whose entries have not been accepted.
- **b)** In case the Rally is not realised.
- c) The organisers may refund part of the entry fee to those competitors who for reasons of "force major" duly certified by their ASN, are unable to start the rally.

5. INSURANCE COVER

- 5.1. The entry fee includes the insurance premium, which guarantees the Competitor cover for civil liability towards third parties. This insurance cover is limited to 48.560.000,00 € and 9.760.000,00 €, per accident, for bodily injury and material damage respectively.
- **5.2.** The insurance cover will come into effect from administrative checks and will cease at the end of the event or the moment of retirement, disqualification or exclusion. This policy will also cover vehicles taking part in the shakedown.
- 5.3. Only the damage caused by the holding drivers is covered by the insurance policy taken out by the Organisation. This insurance does not cover injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating cars.
- **5.4.** Entrants and competitors are free to carry any individual insurance policy that they choose, independently from the liability mentioned above insurance.
- 5.5. In case of an accident, competitors and drivers agree to exclude responsibility and keep indemnified the event's promoters and organisers (Club Sports Madeira and Organising Committee of Rally) against all claims.
- 5.6. In case of an accident, the competitor or representative <u>needs to notify the Clerk of the Course</u> in writing, as soon as possible, and <u>within the maximal delay of 24 hours allowed</u>. Notification must provide details about the accident including damages and consequences to persons or property, and identification of any witnesses who observed the incident. Names and contact information of any injured person(s) need to be identified.
- **5.7.** The service vehicles, even those bearing special plates issued by the organiser, may never be considered official participants in the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

6. ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

See Appendix 4 of SR "DECALS AND POSITIONING OF SUPPLEMENTARY ADVERTISING".

6.1. Obligatory organiser's advertising

Competition number size: 67 x 17 cm - Rali Vinho da Madeira

The organiser will provide each crew with the number identification (67x17cm), which must be affixed to their car in the stated positions before scrutineering. Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. It is not allowed to cut the panel.

- **6.1.1.** The advertising spaces situated immediately above or immediately below the competition numbers, as well as other suitable spaces on the Rally plates, are reserved for the Organiser's advertising. Such advertising is obligatory and may not be refused by the competitors/entrants. (Appendix 4).
- **6.1.2.** Those failing to observe the above advertising conditions (Art. 6.1) will be penalised at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.

6.2. Optional organiser's advertising

Competitors who accept the Organiser's optional advertising must reserve spaces for it, as specified in this Supplementary Regulation (Appendix 4).

6.3. Competition Numbers and Rally Plates

6.3.1. Competitions Number

The competition numbers supplied by the Organisers must be affixed to both front doors during the whole Rally (see appendix 4). The lack of a competition number plate is penalised with a fine of € 250. The lack of 2 competition number plates implies the exclusion.

6.3.2. Issuing of Competition Numbers

The plates, the competition numbers and the advertising plates will be available to all Rally Competitors at the Rally Headquarters from <u>Saturday</u>, 29th July.

All numbers, plates and advertising material on the cars will be checked during the scrutineering.

6.3.3. Driver and co-driver names

The first initial(s) and surname of both driver and co-driver, followed by the national flags of the country of the ASN from which they have obtained their licences, must appear on the rear side window on both sides of the car, adjacent to the competition number. The names must be:

In white Helvetica

In upper case for the initial(s) and the first letter of each name with the remainder in lower case 6 cm high and with a stroke width of 1.0 cm.

The driver's name shall be the upper name on both sides of the car

6.3.4. Plates

The Rally plates must be fixed to the front and rear of the car in a visible position for the duration of the.

Rally. The front plate must under no circumstances cover, even partially, the car's licence plate. Non-compliance of the above implies a cash penalty of € 500.

The lack of a plate is penalised with a fine of € 250

6.4. Numbers awarded

The numbers shall be awarded in the following order:

Series 1: drivers seeded by FIA

Series 2: all the other drivers entered in the following order:

- 1. Drivers seeded by respective National Federations (ASN's and FPAK) Notoriety
- **2.** All others are let to the initiative of the Organisers.

7. TYRES

7.1. Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the rally

Only moulded Tyres are permitted.

Tyres to be used in vehicles must be according to the list of eligible asphalt tyres as published FIA list https://www.fia.com/sites/default/files/2023-01-20_asphalt_cut_wet_patterns.pdf

For cars in group **X5 16 (RGT)** tire cutting is only allowed under the conditions that manual cutting in accordance with the standard accredited by the tire manufacturer for the FIA.

(Appendix V1B, Art. 13.7. of 2023 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations)

7.2. Tyres For Reconnaissance Cars

In accordance with Art. 35.2 a) . of 2023 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations

7.3. Car Equipment

The car may carry a maximum of two spare wheels, during the event, duly fixed. The spare wheel(s) may be equipped with tyre(s) of a different type, but at least one of the spare wheels must be carried on board the vehicle during the event.

At no time during the event must the depth of the grooves of the tyres which equip the vehicle to be less than 1,6 mm on at least three-quarters of the surface.

7.4. Marking of Tyres

The marking of tyres is obligatory for all the competitors entered in the Rally. During the event, the following points must be noted:

- All tyres will be marked throughout the Rally per the 2023 Sporting Regulations applicable to all FIA Regional Rally Appendix V.
- At the Start of each section in the Tyre Marking Zone, at the exit of the Service Park, the
 four tyres mounted on the car and the possible spare tyre(s), will be marked using a
 special ink, the same colour for all the competitors and using a different colour in each
 section.

- Tyres which have not been used in the previous section, or which, even if they have already been used, are nevertheless in conformity with the regulations, must be marked again.

A tyre-marking zone reserved exclusively for this purpose shall be established at the exit from the Service Park or refuelling zone, and the tyre-marking zone shall denote its entrance and exit. For the sole purpose of assisting with the tyre marking procedure, and only for the period during which the car is in that zone, one member of the team of each crew may have access to this zone.

7.5. Control

At any time during the event, controls may be carried out to check the conformity of tyres. In everything else, will be applied **Article 13 and Appendix V** to the 2023 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations.

8. FUEL

8.1. Permitted Fuel

All competitors must only use fuel meeting the requirements of Appendix J (Art. 252.9).

8.2. Refuelling Zones

Refuelling may only be performed during the rally inside the designated refuelling zones as specified in the Road Book and accordance of with 2023 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations (Art. 61).

- **8.2.1.** For environmental reasons, it's <u>mandatory for the teams</u> to use a <u>protective canvas</u>, to avoid spilling fuel onto the ground.
- **8.2.2. Only** two members of the team, identified by the Specific Bracelets supplied by the organisation may access the refuelling zone, exclusively to support the refuelling process. It is expressly forbidden the presence of any team member wearing any shorts such as "Bermuda" or "reduced" clothing, as well as the presence of any person under 18 years of age. The relevant personnel must be wearing clothing (suit, balaclava and gloves) which will provide adequate protection against fire (Art. 12.7.6 das PER e 61.2.3 do RRR FIA).

In case of a breakdown, the vehicle must be pushed out of the refuelling area, by the team, by the Marshals or by the two elements above-mentioned, without incurring any penalty.

8.2.3. According to **Customs Circular Letter - IEC N.º 35.191, of 09/02/2023**, from that date, shipments and receipts of products subject to taxes (fuel included), will no longer be made using procedures supported on paper (as was done by the RVM – CSM), **which can only be carried out by operators duly accredited with the Customs.**

Since there are specific procedures for transporting fuel and/or oils, teams that pretend to transport this type of product should request additional information to Cristina Lume, via E-Mail: transportes@ralivm.com.

Noncompliance with the requirements may result in Customs' seizure of the implicated products.

9. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance will be according to FIA RRSR Art. 35. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in **Appendix 2** of these supplementary regulations.

Obligatory insurance must cover reconnaissance cars under current legislation, with no responsibility being imputable to the Organisers. In case of an accident, during reconnaissance, the competitor or representative <u>has the obligation to inform</u> the organization, of all details of it.

9.1. Procedure for registration

Drivers who wish to carry out reconnaissance will have to register previously at www.ralivm.com.

When delivering the material to the competitors, a time control will be given, which always accompany the vehicle during reconnaissance. This time control will be endorsed at each pass through each Special Stage. Failure to present this time control will result in refusal to participate in the reconnaissance. The reconnaissance time control must be handed in at the Administrative Checks, on Wednesday, August 2nd, from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Competitors will be issued with two reconnaissance numbers that must be fixed to the inside of the front and rear windscreens.

Should a crew's reconnaissance car be replaced for any reason, the Rally Office must be informed of the details of the replacement car.

9.2. Specific Regulation

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulations must be followed. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organiser may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Speeding during reconnaissance will be penalised according to FIA RRSR Article 34.2. The speed check will be performed by the GPS device that will be mounted in the vehicle.

The number of passages is limited to three for each driver and each special stage.

No more than two persons are permitted in the car during each passage through a special stage, these persons being the driver and the co-driver of the competing crew.

Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, <u>except in the first 420 meters (0.42 Km) of Campo de Golfe SS and the first 1.500 meters (1.5 Km) of Calheta SS</u>. Competitors may only enter a special stage through the Start and exit through the Finishing Line.

National restrictions – speed limit

For passenger and mixed cars without a trailer the maximum speed is:

- 50 km/h in urban/built-up areas;
- 40 km/h in Funchal City;
- 90 km/h on Expressways or Motorways, main routes marked "Via Expresso" or "Via Rapida" (VE and VR on maps);
- 70 km/h on other public roads.

The exceptions will be indicated by vertical signalling

Drivers who exceed the maximum authorised speed not only incur the penalty of a fine as it can lead to a driving license suspension, according to the table below:

120,00€ - 600,00€	inside urban/built-up areas	Excessive speed above 10 km/h and up to 20 km/h	If the infraction is considered very serious, a suspension or revocation of the driver's license

The responsibility for the infraction or infractions will fall directly to its author / accused. The fines above are applied by the police.

9.3. Fitment of Speed control checking devices

For reconnaissance, competitors will have to install speed and location control equipment in their vehicles, GPS. Which will be delivered, along with the rest of the material (Appendix 7).

The GPS of the reconnaissance must be returned on Wednesday 2nd August 2023, during Administrative Checks, at Praça CR7, Av. Dr. Sá Carneiro.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKS

10.1. Timetable

Wednesday, 2nd August 2023 from 17:00 to 20:00 hours – Praça CR7 (A detailed timetable will be published indicating the time for the administrative checks of each team)

10.2. Documents to be presented:

<u>Both crews'</u> members must report to the administrative checks with the following <u>original</u> documents:

- Entrant competition license
- Driver and Co-Driver's competition license
- Driver and Co-Driver's passport or identity cards
- Driver and Co-Driver's driving Licences
- ASN authorisation, for all foreign competitors
- Rally car Documentation
- Car owner authorisation to participate in the rally
- In the case where the competition vehicle ownership is not registered to either of the drivers, a notarized document from the owner is required, authorising the vehicle to participate in the 2023 edition of Rali Vinho da Madeira.
- Completion of all details on the entry form

It is compulsory to complete the Administrative Checks before Scrutineering.

The above-indicated documents must be presented in their original form. Copies will not be accepted.

11. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1. Timetable

(A detailed timetable will be published indicating the time for the administrative checks of each team)

11.1.1. Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)

11.1.2. Sealing of Turbos, Gear Boxes, Transmissions

During Scrutineering, and in the pre-defined location at Pontão Norte do Porto do Funchal, the Sealing of Turbos, Gear Boxes, Transmissions, and respective spare parts will be carried out following the 2019 Appendix "J", Art. 254.6.1 (Group N) and Art. 255.5.1.8.3 (Group A) of the International Sporting Code. The competitors should present their vehicles and spare parts (Turbos, Gear Boxes and Differentials). Competitors are required to bring all equipment appropriately wired and ready to be sealed and verified.

11.2. Mudflaps

Mud flaps are authorised and must comply with Appendix "J" (Art. 252.7.7)

11.3. Windows / Nets

The use of silver or tinted films, in conformity with article 253.11 of Appendix "J" of the International Sporting Code, is authorized.

11.4. Driver's safety equipment

Competitors, HANS devices and flame resistant clothing will be carried out at the time of Technical Scrutineering, by the timetable stipulated in the event programme and in conformity with Appendix L, chapter III.

11.5. Noise level

The noise level must conform with Appendix "J"

11.6. Installation of Safety Tracking System

All competition cars will be using GPS (Global Positioning System) equipment during the event and for reconnaissance (Art. 9.3 and Appendix 7).

11.7. Installation of Event Safety Tracking System

The installation of the GPS mounting Kit as to be done as described in Appendix 7. The GPS tracking system for the event will be checked right before the scrutineering at Pontão Norte – Cais 6 Porto do Funchal.

12. OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

12.1. Rally Start procedures and order

The Rally Start will take place from the Starting Parc Fermé (PF) at Praça do Município, on Thursday 3rd August at 15:52 hours.

All cars authorised to start Leg 1 are required to enter at the Starting Parc Fermé, located at Praça do Município, between 15:00 and 15:50 hours, on Thursday 3rd August, following the schedule in **Appendix 8.**

12.2. Finish procedures

The Rally finish on Saturday, 5th August 18:30 hours, passing the podium, at Praça do Povo, Avenida do Mar e das Comunidades Madeirenses – Funchal with Prize Giving.

12.3. Permitted early check-in

Early check-in is permitted on arrival at the **CH 7D**, crews can check-in in advance without incurring any penalty. Early check-in is permitted on arrival at the **CH 15F**, crews can check in for delay without incurring any penalty. Through the Prize Giving, competitors may need to be checked by Time Control **CH 15E**, without incurring any penalty.

12.4. Special Event Procedures Show and Starting Order

The official start of the Rally will be at 15:52 at Praça do Município, on August 3, 2023. The vehicles will depart in accordance with the Sporting Regulations of the FIA 2023 Regional Championships, except as indicated in the table below:

The official final classification will not be distributed after the event. The final classification will be published on the Digital Notice Board at APP Sportity

The International protest fee is € 1.000,00.

If a protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of defined parts of a car, the claimant must, on other hand, deposit the following additional values.

In case of protest with dismantling the deposit, the fee has to be calculated by the chief scrutineer and approved by the stewards.

15.3. Appeal deposit

The sum for an international appeal fee (FIA) is € 3.000,00


A – Competition Number – Two **(2)** rectangular panels measuring 67 x 17 cm (RVM) for both front doors of the car with the number facing the front of the car (7 to 10 cm of the bottom line of the side window)

B – Competition Number – Two **(2)** competition numbers measuring 20 cm high, one for each rear side window

C – Front Plate – One **(1)** front plate measuring 43 x 21,5 cm (RVM) placed on the bonnet of the car

D – Competition Number – One **(1)** competition number for the rear window, measuring 14 cm high, to be placed on the upper right-hand side of the window (as shown in the drawing)

E – Madeira Island Banners – Two **(2)** Madeira Islands banners are to be placed at the top of the front windshield and rear window. <u>It is allowed to place any other advertising banner on the windscreen of the vehicle as well as on the rear window, provided that it is <u>placed higher.</u> (as shown in the drawing).</u>

APPENDIX 5 EXTRACT FROM FIA "APPENDIX L" RELATING TO DRIVER'S EQUIPMENT

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment. These regulations apply to shakedown and qualifying as well.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the following FIA standards:

- 8858-2002 or 8858-2010 (Technical List N°41),
- 8859-2015 (Technical List N°49),
- 8860-2004 or 8860-2010 (Technical List N°33), or
- 8860-2018 or 8860-2018-ABP (Technical List N°69)

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858. Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29. See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74).

Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 concerning embroidery and printing on flame-resistant clothing (manufacturer certificates etc.) as well as concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also Regional Rally Sporting Regulations, Article 53.1.

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing or metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.


APPENDIX 6 RADIO LICENSES


All radio-electric transmitter installations in cars are always subject to a previous authorisation request. All 2-way radio equipment used must operate with consecutive channel spacing of 12.5 kHz. REQUEST MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY





We will have to confirm if we need a doctor and then wait for the instructions that will send us from the HQ. Approaching vehicles will receive an SOS on their screen. The first two vehicles to arrive, you should press the SOS alert on your stella, and help the crashed pilots.

The SOS alert should not be sent in cases of minor accidents, mechanical problems or any circumstance that does not involve danger for participants.








CAUTION VEHICLE STATIONARY



If we have any other reason to stop within a special section, we will press the red button for at least 3 seconds until a triangle appears on the LED screen. We will send to HQ the message that best suits our situation. This alarm will alert nearby vehicles to prevent a possible collision.

The HQ can send us messages or questions that can be answered with OK, YES or NO



At the end of the Rally, ANUBE will collect the GPS Tracking System at Parc Fermé (TC 15F). In case of retirement, the competitor must contact the organization in the Rally Headquarters where they must return the equipment no later than August 5Th at 20:45.


Bracket must be installed on the dashboard or panel, stella 3 bottons <u>must be visible and accessible by the rider in case of emergency</u>.

It is mandatory to leave the cables with at least 15 cm of clearance for later connections.

2. POWER CABLE

Connect RED wire to +12v and GREY wire to negative It must be connected directly to the battery (no breaker and no contact on power)

We recommend to install a 3A fuse (not included) Then, bring power connector close to bracket



3. ANTENNAS: RADIO / GPS FREQUENCY

The antennas must be installed in vehicle roof.

It is strongly advised to place plastic collars and tape to maintain the antennas. They must be installed clear of all metal o carbon fiber obstacles.

All cars authorised to start the LEG 1 is required to enter at the starting Parc Fermé, located at Praça do Município, between 15:00 and 15:50 hours, on Thursday, 3rd August 2023, in accordance with the following schedule:

Any impediment to the designated schedule will incur a penalty of € 200.

APPENDIX 9 SERVICE PARK

Location

There is one Service Park for the entire Rally. The Service Park is located at Av. Dr. Sá Carneiro of Funchal and North Quay of Funchal Harbour.

Space allocated in the Service Park is limited to the area described in 4.4.2. Occupation of an area superior to the designated allotment will require that the competitor pay 2.500€ (two thousand five hundred Euros) for each additional 10m². No trailer, of any type, is allowed to enter the Service Park and/or Auxiliary Park. Competitors will be allotted servicing areas inside the Park following the 2023 FIA Regional Rally Championship Sporting Regulations. However, the location can be changed at the entrance of the vehicles in Assistance Park, for reasons of space management.

By no later than July 24rd, 2023, Competitors must inform the Organisers of any possible association, concerning service vehicles and with other Competitors. The lack of this information requires a free location under the criteria of the organisation.

It is mandatory to use ground floor protection in the Service Park which should cover the entire servicing area of the competition vehicle and should be of an impermeable material. Failure to use this protection will incur a payment of an amount between € 2.500,00 and € 5.000,00 for the organisation to provide this material.

It is forbidden to use any space other than what is delineated for the Service Park in Sea Porto of Funchal. Therefore, it is forbidden to use any public pedestrian promenade area by any competitor.

The Service Park will need to be cleared by 20:00 hours on August 5th (Saturday). After this time, the local and marine Police will act by current legislation to remove any remaining vehicle.

Any doubt regarding the operation of the Service Park should be made by e-mail and addressed to the Organizing Committee by 24th July 2023. All responses will be given until 24 hours after it requests clarification.

Access time to Service Park for Service Vehicles

Thursday, 3rd August – from 13:00 to 15:30 hours (park mount time)

Friday, 4th August – from 07:00 to 08:00 hours Saturday, 5th August – from 07:00 to 08:00 hours

On Thursday, August 3, there will be no exit/movement of vehicles from the Service Park to the Rotunda Dr. Sá Carneiro, from 14:00 hours, since the traffic will be closed in this area.

Any delay incurred will be penalized by a decision(s) pronounced by the Stewards of the Meeting. No vehicle will be authorised entry into the Service Park outside the stipulated schedule, except for rally cars.

Other Points

- Only vehicles identified with corresponding service plates (Service) will be allowed to enter and stay in the Service Park in indicated above schedule. The service vehicles can only leave the Service Park if the competitor has been disqualified or desisted.
- Any competitor with a service vehicle inside the Service Park without the respective "Service" Plate duly placed is obligated to pay the amount of € 1.500,00, failing which will lead to the removal of the vehicle from the above-mentioned Service Park.
- The "Service" Plate must be fixed on the top side of the front windscreen.
- All remaining vehicles must be identified by "Auxiliary" Plates which allow access to the park adjacent to the Service Park(a duly identified Parking Area). The "Auxiliary" Plates must be fixed on the top side of the front windscreen.
- The price of each supplementary "Auxiliary" plate is € 750,00.
- No trailer, of any type, is allowed to enter and permanently in the Service Park and/or Auxiliary Park.
- A 1.500,00€ penalty will be levied on the competing team if the exchange of "Service" and/or "Auxiliary" plate(s) is detected during the event. This situation will be reported to the Stewards who may apply another type of sanctions.

APPENDIX 10 FREE PRACTICE/QUALIFYING AND SHAKEDOWN

FREE PRACTICE/QUALIFYING and SHAKEDOWN

This stage will be run in compliance with Article No. 17.5.2 of the 2023 FPAK Rally Specific Prescriptions.

During Shakedown, a special Qualifying test will take place reserved for priority FIA/FPAK and/or other ASN drivers, plus for the ten (10) top drivers of the Portugal Rally Championship, for the first three (3) drivers of the 2RM Portugal Rally Championship and the first three (3) drivers of the GT Portugal Rally Championship, participation is mandatory.

The organization may propose the inclusion of more than 5 drivers with sports curriculum and merit and with a rally car in accordance with the 2023 FIA Regional Rally Sports Regulations and V1b – European Rally Trophy (ERT).

The Free Practice/Qualifying route is the same as the Shakedown and has a length of 3,35 km.

Competitors are required to indicate their choice to participate in the Shakedown, by filling in the obligatory field on the Entry Form.

A section in the Service Road Book will indicate the directions to get from the Rally Office (Escola Profissional Atlântico – Av. Arriaga, 7) and the Shakedown zone, along with a map of the area, indicating the reserved service and refuelling area.

<u>ONLY</u> vehicles with <u>CLEARLY VISIBLE SERVICE and AUXILIARY PLATES</u> will be allowed to park inside Shakedown Service Areas.

APPENDIX 11 OTHER SUBJECTS OF INTEREST

i. Time Card

The time card will be handed out to each Competitor at the:

- a) Start of the Rally (Leg 1 / 1st Section, Start to 2nd Section of Leg 1 and Start to Leg 2)
- b) Time Controls "Service OUT" (beginning of a section)

ii. False Start

A false start will be penalized as follows:

a) First infringement: 10 second time penalty
b) Second infringement: 1 minute time penalty
c) Third infringement: 3 minute time penalty

d) Further infringements: Penalty at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting

These penalties do not prevent the Stewards from imposing heavier penalties if they judge it necessary

iii. Infringements

Throughout the entire Rally, the crews must strictly observe the traffic Laws in Portugal. Any crew that does not comply with the Traffic Laws shall be subject to the penalties set out below:

1st infringement: € 250,00 penalty 2nd infringementa 5 minute time penalty

3rd infringement exclusion

iv. Competitor'stors Safety

Each competing car must carry a red reflective triangle which, in the event of the car stopping in a Special Stage, must be placed by a member of the crew in a conspicuous position at least 50 meters behind the car, to warn following drivers. Any crew failing to comply shall be subject to a cash penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

In the event of an accident where no injuries are sustained requiring immediate medical intervention, the **OK** sign in the road book must be clearly shown by a crewmember to the next three following vehicles. If the crew leaves the vehicle the **OK** sign must be displayed so that it is visible, where possible, to other competitors. If on the other hand urgent medical attention is required, where possible the **SOS** should be immediately displayed to the following cars. The Stewards may penalise any crew, which can, but fails to comply with this rule under the International Sporting Code.

v. Accident Reporting

Accident involving a member of the public

If a driver taking part in a rally is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains a physical injury, the Driver concerned must report this as specified in the road book.

The laws of the country in which the event is conducted must also be complied with concerning procedures for accidents.

Accident investigations

Any accident involving a fatality or serious injury must be reported to the National Sporting Authority which is required to inform the FIA accordingly.

vi. Control Anti-Doping

In case there is an anti-doping control, this will take place as follows:

vii. Penalties

Any other infringement of these rules will be reported to the Stewards, who may impose a penalty as provided for in Article 12 of the International Sporting Code.
