Competitors Safety Briefing: J1000's 07:00am Main Field 07:30am, First Car Away 08:45am, First Car Finish 17:54pm

Rally start will now be at 08:45 and there will not be any overnight Parc Ferme Saturday August 10th, Competitors are asked to Assemble/ Queue in seeded order at the Start Control/ Service Out 10 mins before their published due time on the Start list.

Article 4.1: Reminder: No IRDS/BRDS = NO START, make sure you're on the list, Published on the M.I website every week and please make sure you have a licence that is in date.





Article 7:

Please have both driver and co-driver's competition licences available for inspection at Documentation Sign-on, and you will be asked to ring the emergency phone on the day, to get both driver and co-drivers correct phone numbers.

Article 8: Installation of the safety tracking system The tracking system units will be available for collection just inside the entrance of scrutiny venue, and these units must be fitted by the Crews before entering the scrutineering bay.

Article 10: Timecards will be issued to all competitors before the drivers briefing, and both crew members will be asked to sign in. Attendance is **Mandatory** for both crew members; the penalty for non-attendance is exclusion and non-return of entry fees.

General:

We appeal to the Competitors and their crews to be extra vigilant in Service and on the stages of Fire hazard. Remember the service area & all stages are No Smoking zones & please remind your Teams to have their fire extinguishers visible and on standby.

Security will be provided at HQ/ Mallow Autograss Complex Saturday night. Service Crews are advised to bring Timber pads/ Plywood for Trolley Jacks & Axle Stands as the ground may be a little soft in places, and are reminded that groundsheets <u>must</u> be used.

Please be advised that Mallow Autograss is a remote Venue and whilst there will be a food truck on site from Saturday till event finish there are no services locally so everyone is advised to stock up with supplies, (Fuel, Food, Refreshments etc) on route. There are plenty of shops/ filling stations in Mitchelstown, Kildorrery, Doneraile, Mallow, Charleville, Kilmallock & Kilfinanne.

The road sections are timed very slack, please be mindful of other road users, remember there will be 2 way rally traffic in places & there is also an open day In Ardpatrick on Sunday, so please be extra cautious when approaching and going through the village on route to ss2/4
