Approval Conditions:

Approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. Notification to affected businesses, residents and stakeholders within a one (1) block radius must be completed at least three (3) business days prior to the closure commencing.
2. The Applicant is to ensure that Public Liability Insurance is kept current for the duration of the works, and must also ensure that all Contractors and Subcontractors working within Council road reserves possess and maintain adequate Public Liability Insurance (\$20 million). Any potential claims that result from negligent actions performed by Contractors / Subcontractors engaged by the Applicant within Council road reserves will be borne by the Applicant and not Lithgow City Council.
3. All temporary road closures are to be undertaken in accordance with the approved and stamped Traffic Guidance Scheme (TGS # Rally of Bathurst Road Closures) including location of associated road works signage. Failure to comply may result in SafeWork intervention and may also include Stop Work orders from Council until such time the Applicant complies with suitable traffic management procedures.
4. At all times during the approved closure, traffic queues shall be monitored to ensure that traffic does not exceed beyond the limits of advanced warning signage. Council must be notified on (02) 6354 9999 of any abnormal queuing, or in the event of an incident in the vicinity of the approved temporary road closure area.
5. RMS accredited Traffic Controllers will adhere to the approved TGS according to TCAWS Manual Version 6.1 2022
6. Signs and devices are to be installed and maintained during the approved closure in accordance with the stamped TGS
7. Means of access for local traffic and pedestrians across the work area should be provided and suitable guide signs erected.
8. This temporary traffic control set-up must only be applied during the closure period. Existing conditions are to be reinstated outside of the approved hours, and / or at the completion of the event / works
9. This approval does not constitute an approval to carry out work activities, and relates to the temporary closure of the road / footpath only. Additional approvals for road opening, underboring or using a crane may be required, as well as additional third party approvals for proposed works.
10. Council Officers will be undertaking an inspection during the approval times to ensure compliance with the approved Traffic Control Plan. Should any non-compliance be noted, approval may be immediately revoked, and further action taken by Council for non-compliance with this approval.
