BRIEFING - IMPORTANT REMAINDERS TO ALL COMPETITORS

- 1. Rally car's **extinguisher system must be armed at all times.** This will be checked throughout the rally by the scrutineers and all infringements will be reported to the Stewards who will impose a penalty.
- 2. Drivers must ensure that they wear their safety equipment properly on special stages all the way until the stop control (helmets and seat belts fastened, balaclava inside the overall, overall zipper closed, driver's gloves worn etc.). All infringements will be noticed to the Stewards who may impose a penalty.
- 3. Any crew which has the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has suffered an accident and the OK sign is not shown (alternatively crew member signaling as per reg. 53.3.5 thumb up), shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance. Any crew stopping on a special stage and who does not require immediate medical assistance, must activate the OK display in the FIA safety tracking device within one minute and show the OK sign to all other cars.
- 4. All crews that are shown the Red Flag must immediately slow down and continue that lowered speed until the finish of the stage. The Red Flag can be a physical one shown at radio points or an electronic one sent to the FIA safety tracking device. The electronic Red Flag must be acknowledged by the crew
- 5. To access a refueling zone, all personnel involved in refueling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava. It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refueling. Please see RRSR 61.2.
- 6. Communication N°7 affecting the Road-Book
- 7. It's forbidden to practice movements to warm up the tires (zig-zags)
- **8.** Those who will use the new start modality (Super-Rally) can only be done between the first and second legs, **prior communication through the CRO**.
- In case of any incidence or accident during all the Rally, it's mandatory to communicate with images of the accident and possible material damage through the Emergency Phone +34 690 107 590 using WhatsApp.
- 10. The speed inside the Service Park (including all the itinerary to the Refueling area and the Tire Marking Zone) can't be over 30km/h.
- 11. The start of the Sections will be done from the CH of the Service Park.
