CONCERNS: RECYCLING AT KARTING GENK

Dear all,

Karting Genk has the obligation to collect all waste separately. This means that there will be some changes for teams and drivers.

All waste must be taken home!

Waste can only be left behind under the following conditions and after approval of Karting Genk staff:

- · All waste must be collected in transparent bags. Karting Genk has these available.
- The waste must be collected separately in the tents in the following categories:
 - paper, 0
 - metal,
 - PMD, (plastic, metal and drink bottles and cans)



spray cans and oil bottles





Glass, metal and plastic bodyworks can be left behind in designated containers near the hangar



Tyres can be disposed in the container park as well.



We encourage teams to take the necessary precautions, such as separate garbage holders to ensure the proper sorting out of the waste.

All teams are responsible for their allocated paddock space and they are accountable in case of doubt or problems.

Teams will be charged if any left behind waste after the event proves to be from a certain team.

If a team will be caught deliberately depositing their waste on the paddock space of another team, they will be penalized.



We ask all teams to check their allocated space in the paddock before building up the awning.
